Our program's unique approach to care includes a Circle of Giving program. program requires volunteer hours donated back to the community for each purchase of a hearing device. Not only do our patients pay a minimal fee for services and devices, but they are also giving back to the communities who are giving to them. In 2014, we registered 2,082 volunteer hours by our patients.

HearCare Connection was established as an independent nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization in 2011 to provide low-income and uninsured families reduced fee hearing healthcare on a sliding scale based on income and family size. In January 2012, we began seeing patients and in June 2012 we began accepting Medicaid patients. By the end of 2012, we reached a patient base of 127 individuals. 2013, we added another 98 new patients to our patient base. In 2013, we also began offering monthly community clinics for patients of Matthew25. In 2014, we added another 194 patients to our local clinic brining our total patient base to 417 patients. Since our inception, we have fit over 200 hearing aids.

Services Provided:

>>Monthly Community Hearing Clinic: Reduced fee, sliding scale hearing care services for individuals with incomes up to 250% of Federal Poverty Level in the Fort Wayne area

>>Matthew25 Partnership: Hearing testing and treatment for patients at Matthew25's health and dental clinic

>>Local preschool/daycare screening program servicing preschools and daycares who have 50% or more of their families served through Brightpoint (formerly Community Action of Northeast Indiana). Test pilot program has shown an average of 25% of children fail our initial screenings and must be referred to a physician or an

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other circumstances is severe in the realm of early childhood education. We are trying to raise awareness for the needs of early intervention in preschool aged children.

>>Hearing Aid Donation Box Program: Collection of gently used hearing aids that can be reprogrammed for low-income individuals

>>Annual Hearing Loss Awareness Campaign: Conducted during Better Speech and Hearing Month in May

HearCare Connection's clinic provides hearing screenings and hearing tests; hearing aids and related apparatus; hearing aid maintenance and repairs; and follow up care after initial treatment. We are able to fit individuals with gently used reprogrammable donated hearing aids collected through our community donation program. We also have the ability to purchase new or refurbished hearing aids at greatly reduced costs from the manufacturer.

Fees are based on a sliding scale for family size and income. This ensures that hearing aids are affordable for patients while also requiring them to make a personal investment in their own healthcare. In addition to our nominal fees, we require our patients to complete a set number of volunteer service hours at a not-for-profit agency within our community to earn "sweat equity" for their hearing aids. We call this our "Circle of Giving" model. Because our fees are so low, they do not cover the full costs to operate our program and we rely on the support of the community in the form of donations, fundraisers, and grants to fill in the gap. In turn, we require patients to complete volunteer service hours in the community in addition to their fee schedule for their hearing aids to complete our "Circle". We receive funds from the community to provide services to our patients and our patients return "sweat equity" back to the community. Since 2012, our patients have volunteered over 3,500 hours of service. Many of our patients find their volunteer experience so rewarding they continue to volunteer after their mandatory hours are
