# Harold J. and Rose E. Schneider Charitable Foundation Grant Application Information and Instructions

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### Projects Funded by the Foundation.

The Foundation will provide funding to charitable organizations for projects which benefit Butler County, Pennsylvania and the surrounding communities. The Foundation will concentrate on funding requests for specific, tangible items or projects in which the funds provided by the Foundation will have a substantive impact. The Foundation will not normally provide funding for: (1) program advertising; (2) fundraising events; (3) normal operating expenses; (4) deficit reduction efforts; (5) sectarian religious activities; (6) replacement of government or other funding; and (7) organization start ups.

#### Organizations Eligible to Receive Funding.

In order to receive funding from the Foundation, an organization must normally be tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. However, if an organization does not have this designation, it may still be eligible to apply if another tax-exempt organization acts as its fiscal agent.

#### **Timetables and Process**

The Foundation will normally consider grant applications on a semi-annual basis at its regular meetings in May and November. In order to assure consideration of an application at a particular meeting, applications should be received by the Foundation by the following deadlines.

April 1	May
October 1	November

The foregoing deadlines are not intended to preclude the receipt and consideration of applications outside such time frames. However, absent unusual circumstances, the Foundation would normally expect to process applications in accordance with this schedule.

#### Form of Application.

The Foundation requests that Applicants use the form of application which is attached.

The form of application is not intended to be "one size fits all". Applicants are encouraged to submit any additional information which the Applicant deems relevant in the form of attachments to the application.

If the Board of Directors is familiar with certain charitable organziations, the Foundation will still require the basic grant application information in order to enable it to determine not only that the organization is a qualified recipient, but that the proposed funding request meets the Foundation's criterion.

The Foundation's objective is to benefit charitable organizations that support and enhance the charitable and educational purposes for which it was organized.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Section 1.1 Name of Applicant. It is important that you provide us with the full correct legal name of the Applicant, including any corporate designation such as "Inc.".
- Section 1.4 Section 501(c)(3) Organization. It is important for the Foundation to know whether the applicant is a Section 501(c)(3) tax exempt organization. If you are uncertain as to the status of your organization, your accountant or legal adviser can assist you in determining the organization's status.
- Section 2.1 Amount Requested From Foundation. Please specify the entire amount of the grant being requested.
- Section 2.2 Date(s) Disbursement(s) Requested. Please provide the date by which the funding is required. If you are requesting funding in more than one disbursement, please indicate the dates on which you are requesting funding and the amount of each disbursement.
- **Section 2.3 Project Description**. Please describe the project in reasonable detail. You are not limited to the space provided, but may provide whatever description you believe appropriate. You may attach the description as a separate document marked "Attachment 2.3". The same applies to Sections 2.4 through 2.8.

If you are acquiring equipment or similar tangible items, please describe the items and attach, if practical, brochures or other product literature describing the items.

- Section 2.4 Project Purpose and Community Benefit. To the extent not covered in Section 2.3, please describe the benefit of the project to Butler County, Pennsylvania and/or the surrounding communities.
