#### **Report on the Financial Statements**

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Community Memorial Hospital, Inc., which comprise the balance sheets as of December 31, 2014 and 2013, and the related statements of operations, changes in net assets, and cash flows for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

#### Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

#### Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audits. We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

## Note 1 - Organization and Significant Accounting Policies

#### **Organization**

Community Memorial Hospital, Inc. (Hospital) is a 16-bed acute care hospital and medical clinic located in Burke, South Dakota and a medical clinic located in Bonesteel, South Dakota. The Hospital is organized as a South Dakota nonprofit corporation and is exempt from federal income tax.

Management services are provided to the Hospital by Sanford Regional Health Network under a management services agreement (Note 11).

#### **Income Taxes**

The Hospital is organized as a South Dakota nonprofit corporation and has been recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as exempt from federal income taxes under Internal Revenue Service Code Section 501(c)(3). The Hospital is annually required to file a Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax (Form 990) with the IRS. In addition, the Hospital is subject to income tax on net income that is derived from business activities that are unrelated to its exempt purpose. The Organization has determined it is not subject to unrelated business income tax and has not filed an Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return (Form 990-T) with the IRS.

The Hospital believes that it has appropriate support for any tax positions taken affecting its annual filing requirements, and as such, does not have any uncertain tax positions that are material to the financial statements. The Hospital would recognize future accrued interest and penalties related to unrecognized tax benefits and liabilities in income tax expense if such interest and penalties are incurred.

#### **Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements. Estimates also affect the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include highly liquid investments with an original maturity of three months or less.

#### **Patient Receivables**

Patient receivables are uncollateralized customer and third-party payor obligations. Unpaid patient receivables, excluding amounts due from third-party payors, with invoice dates over 90 days old have interest assessed at 0.75% per month. Interest income is recognized at the time it is charged to the account. Payments of patient receivables are allocated to the specific claims identified on the remittance advice or, if unspecified, are applied to the earliest unpaid claim.

Patient accounts receivable are reduced by an allowance for doubtful accounts. In evaluating the collectability of accounts receivable, the Hospital analyzes its past history and identifies trends for each of its major payor sources of revenue to estimate the appropriate allowance for doubtful accounts and provision for bad debts. Management regularly reviews data about these major payor sources of revenue in evaluating the sufficiency of the allowance for doubtful accounts.

For receivables associated with services provided to patients who have third party coverage, the Hospital analyzes contractually due amounts and provides an allowance for doubtful accounts and a provision for bad debts, if necessary (for example, for expected uncollectible deductibles and copayments on accounts for which the third-party payor has not yet paid, or for payors who are known to be having financial difficulties that make the realization of amounts due unlikely). For receivables associated with self-pay patients (which includes both patients without insurance and patients with deductible and copayment balances due for which third-party coverage exists for part of the bill), the Hospital records a significant provision for bad debts in the period of service on the basis of its past experience, which indicates that many patients are unable or unwilling to pay the portion of their bill for which they are financially responsible. The difference between the standard rates (or the discounted rates, if negotiated) and the amounts actually collected after all reasonable collection efforts have been exhausted is charged off against the allowance for doubtful accounts.

The Hospital's process for calculating the allowance for doubtful accounts for self-pay patients has not significantly changed from December 31, 2013. The Hospital does not maintain a material allowance for doubtful accounts from third-party payors, nor did it have significant write offs from third-party payors. The Hospital has not significantly changed its charity care or uninsured discount policies during fiscal years 2014 or 2013.

#### Notes Receivable

The notes receivable is stated at the principal amount plus accrued interest and is collateralized. Payments of notes receivable is allocated first to accrued and unpaid interest with the remainder to the outstanding principal balance. Management reviews the notes receivable periodically and estimates a portion, if any, of the balance that will not be collected.

#### **Supplies**

Supplies are stated at lower of cost (first-in, first-out) or market.

#### **Investment and Interest Income**

Investments in equity securities with readily determinable fair values and all investments in debt securities are measured at fair value in the balance sheet. Investment income or loss (including realized gains and losses on investments, interest, and dividends) is included in revenues in excess of expenses unless the income or loss is restricted by donor or law. Unrealized gains and losses on investments are excluded from revenues in excess of expenses unless the investments are trading securities.

#### Fair Value Measurements

The Hospital has determined the fair value of certain assets and liabilities in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, which provides a framework for measuring fair value.

Fair value is defined as the exchange price that would be received for an asset or paid to transfer a liability (an exit price) in the principal or most advantageous market for the asset or liability in an orderly transaction between market participants on the measurement date. Valuation techniques should maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

A fair value hierarchy has been established, which prioritizes the valuation inputs into three broad levels. Level 1 inputs consist of quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities that the reporting entity has the ability to access at the measurement date. Level 2 inputs are inputs other than quoted prices included within Level 1 that are observable for the related asset or liability. Level 3 inputs are unobservable inputs related to the asset or liability.

#### **Property and Equipment**

Property and equipment acquisitions in excess of \$5,000 are capitalized and recorded at cost. Depreciation is provided over the estimated useful life of each depreciable asset and is computed on the straight-line method. The estimated useful lives of property and equipment are as follows:

Gifts of long-lived assets such as land, buildings, or equipment are reported as unrestricted net assets, and are excluded from revenues in excess of expenses, unless explicit donor stipulations specify how the donated assets must be used. Gifts of long-lived assets with explicit restrictions that specify how the assets are to be used and gifts of cash or other assets that must be used to acquire long-lived assets are reported as restricted support.

Absent explicit donor stipulations about how long those long-lived assets must be maintained, expirations of donor restrictions are reported when donated or when acquired long-lived assets are placed in service.

#### **Temporarily and Permanently Restricted Net Assets**

Temporarily restricted net assets are those whose use by the Hospital has been limited by donors to a specific time period or purpose. Permanently restricted net assets have been restricted by donors to be maintained by the Hospital in perpetuity. At December 31, 2014 and 2013, the Hospital did not have any permanently restricted net assets.

#### **Revenue in Excess of Expenses**

Revenues in excess of expenses excludes unrealized gains and losses on investments other than trading securities, transfers of assets to and from related parties for other than goods and services, and contributions of long-lived assets, including assets acquired using contributions which were restricted by donors.

#### **Net Patient Service Revenue**

The Hospital has agreements with third-party payors that provide for payments to the Hospital at amounts different from its established rates. Payment arrangements include reimbursed costs, discounted charges and per diem payments. Net patient service revenue is reported at the estimated net realizable amounts from patients, third-party payors, and others for services rendered, including estimated retroactive adjustments under reimbursement agreements with third-party payors. Retroactive adjustments are accrued on an estimated basis in the period the related services are rendered and adjusted in future periods as final settlements are determined.

The Hospital recognizes patient service revenue associated with services provided to patients who have third-party payor coverage on the basis of contractual rates for the services rendered, as noted above. For uninsured patients that do not qualify for charity care, the Hospital recognizes revenue on the basis of its standard rates for services provided. On the basis of historical experience, a significant portion of the Hospital's uninsured patients will be unable or unwilling to pay for the services provided. Thus, the Hospital records a significant provision for bad debts related to uninsured patients in the period the services are provided. Net patient service revenue, but before the provision for bad debts, recognized for the years ended December 31, 2014 and 2013 from these major payor sources, is as follows:

#### **Charity Care**

The Hospital provides health care services to patients who meet certain criteria under its Charity Care Policy without charge or at amounts less than its established rates. Since the Hospital does not pursue collection of amounts, they are not reported as patient service revenue. The estimated cost of providing these services was \$16,000 and \$33,000 for the years ended December 31, 2014 and 2013, calculated by multiplying the ratio of cost to gross charges for the Hospital by the gross uncompensated charges associated with providing charity care to it patients.

#### **Donor-Restricted Gifts**

Unconditional promises to give cash and other assets are reported at fair value at the date the promise is received. Conditional promises to give and indications of intentions to give are reported at fair value at the date the gift is received. The gifts are reported as either temporarily or permanently restricted support if they are received with donor stipulations that limit the use of the donated assets. When donor stipulated time restriction or purpose restrictions are met or accomplished, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified as unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of operations as net assets released from restrictions. Donor-restricted contributions whose restrictions are met within the same year as received are reflected as unrestricted contributions in the statements of operations.

#### **Advertising Costs**

The Hospital expenses advertising costs as incurred.

#### **Electronic Health Records Incentive Payments**

To qualify for the EHR incentive payments, hospitals and physicians must meet designated EHR meaningful use criteria. In addition, hospitals must attest that they have used certified EHR technology, satisfied the meaningful use objectives, and specify the EHR reporting period. This attestation is subject to audit by the federal government or its designee. The EHR incentive payment to hospitals for each payment year is calculated as a product of (1) allowable costs as defined by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and (2) the Medicare share. Once the initial attestation of meaningful use is completed, critical access hospitals receive the entire EHR incentive payment for submitted allowable costs of the respective periods in a lump sum, subject to a final adjustment on the cost report.

The Hospital recognizes EHR incentive payments as revenue when there is reasonable assurance that the Hospital will comply with the conditions attached to the incentive payments. EHR incentive payments are included in other operating revenue in the accompanying financial statements. The amount of EHR incentive payments recognized are based on management's best estimate and those amounts are subject to change due to Medicare audits with such changes impacting the period in which they occur. The amount of EHR incentive payment revenue for the year ended December 31, 2014 for Medicare and Medicaid was and \$-0- and \$52,000, respectively. The amount of EHR incentive payment revenue for the year ended December 31, 2013 for Medicare and Medicaid was \$-0- and \$104,000, respectively.

#### **Subsequent Events**

The Hospital has evaluated subsequent events through March 19, 2015, the date which the financial statements were available to be issued.

#### Note 2 - Net Patient Service Revenue

The Hospital has agreements with third-party payers that provide for payments to the Hospital at amounts different from its established rates. A summary of the payment arrangements with major third-party payers follows:

**Medicare:** The Hospital is licensed as a Critical Access Hospital (CAH). The Hospital is reimbursed for most acute care services under a cost reimbursement methodology with final settlement determined after submission of annual cost reports by the Hospital and are subject to audits thereof by the Medicare intermediary. The Hospital's Medicare cost reports have been audited by the Medicare fiscal intermediary through the year ended December 31, 2012.

**Medicare** – **Clinic:** The Burke clinic is designated as a Certified Provider Based Rural Health Clinic by the Medicare program. As a result, clinical services rendered to Medicare program beneficiaries are reimbursed at cost based on a tentative rate with final settlement determined after submission of the Hospital's annual cost reports and audits thereof by the Medicare fiscal intermediary.

**Medicaid:** Inpatient acute care services rendered to Medicaid program beneficiaries are paid on a percentage of charges basis. These rates currently are 95% for inpatient and 90% for outpatient. Clinical services are paid on a fixed fee schedule for rural health clinic services.

**Blue Cross:** Services rendered to Blue Cross subscribers are reimbursed under a prospectively determined percentage of charges methodology.

The Hospital has also entered into payment agreements with certain commercial insurance carriers and other organizations. The basis for payment to the Hospital under these agreements includes prospectively determined rates per discharge, discounts from established charges, and prospectively determined daily rates.

Revenue from the Medicare and Medicaid programs accounted for approximately 60.5% and 11.0% of the Hospital's net patient service revenue for the year ended December 31, 2014 and 67.5% and 7.2% for the year ended December 31, 2013. Laws and regulations governing the Medicare, Medicaid, and other programs are extremely complex and subject to interpretation. As a result, there is at least a reasonable possibility that recorded estimates will change by a material amount in the near term.

In 2014 and 2013, net assets were released from donor restrictions by incurring expenditures satisfying the restricted purposes in the amounts of 15,083 and \$-0-. These amounts are included in net assets released from restrictions in the accompanying financial statements.

#### Note 8 - Pension Plan

The Hospital has a defined contribution pension plan under which employees become participants upon reaching age 21, completion of one year of service and work a minimum of 1,000 hours per year. Employer contributions of 3 percent for 2014 and 2013 of annual compensation were deposited with the plan trustee who invests the plan assets. Total pension expense for the years ended December 31, 2014 and 2013, was \$52,485 and \$48,870, respectively.

#### Note 9 - Concentration of Credit Risk

The Hospital grants credit without collateral to its patients, most of whom are insured under third-party payor agreements. The mix of receivables from third-party payors and patients at December 31, 2014 and 2013, was as follows:

#### Note 11 - Contingencies and Commitments

#### **Management Agreements**

The Hospital has a management agreement with Winner Regional Healthcare Center and Sanford Regional Health Network (Sanford) to manage the Hospital and provide certain management advisory services and information system services. The agreement shall continue through July 31, 2022; however either party may cancel this agreement without cause by providing 180 days written notice. Under the terms of the management agreements, the Hospital is to reimburse Sanford for the salary and benefits of the Hospital's Chief Executive Officer, who is an employee of Sanford, plus an annual base amount which totaled \$37,964 and \$37,403 for the years ended December 31, 2014 and 2013, for management services provided. The information system fees incurred totaled \$94,766 and \$99,236 for the years ended December 31, 2014 and 2013, respectively.

#### **Malpractice Insurance**

The Hospital has malpractice insurance coverage to provide protection for professional liability losses on a claims-made basis subject to a limit of \$1 million per claim and an annual aggregate limit of \$5 million. Should the claims-made policy not be renewed or replaced with equivalent insurance, claims based on occurrences during its term, but reported subsequently, will be uninsured.

#### Litigations, Claims, and Other Disputes

The Hospital is subject to the usual contingencies in the normal course of operations relating to the performance of its tasks under its various programs. In the opinion of management, the ultimate settlement of litigation, claims, and disputes in process will not be material to the financial position of the Hospital.

The health care industry is subject to numerous laws and regulations of federal, state, and local governments. Compliance with these laws and regulations, specifically those relating to the Medicare and Medicaid programs, can be subject to government review and interpretation, as well as regulatory actions unknown and unasserted at this time. Federal government activity has increased with respect to investigations and allegations concerning possible violations by health care providers of regulations, which could result in the imposition of significant fines and penalties, as well as significant repayments of previously billed and collected revenues from patient and resident services.
