Our Mission

The Genentech Foundation provides financial support to qualified nonprofit, U.S.-based charitable organizations. The Foundation awards grants in support of organizations that undertake charitable activities in the areas of:

- Health science education (undergraduate and graduate level research programs)
- · Community-wide civic initiatives
- Programs that provide "everyday needs" assistance for veterans with PTSD and families of children with cancer.



Funding Priorities

The Genentech Foundation is a U.S.-based, private charitable foundation whose donations are made possible by contributions from Genentech. The foundation supports organizations that have a clear mission, a well-defined target service population, programs with a meaningful impact, and are aligned with the focus areas below.

Health Science Education

The Foundation funds schools, universities and nonprofit organizations committed to furthering health science education to help develop the next generation of scientists. We are currently directing a majority of our health science education funds towards two areas:

The Foundation is committed to understanding the needs of the communities in which we operate and partnering with local organizations to alleviate poverty and support those living in our communities. Given the current economic climate, our community focus areas include:

- Access to food and hunger relief
- Housing for individuals and families
- Job training for youth and adults

Geographic Focus

We will consider grant applications from organizations serving individuals in the cities of Oceanside, South San Francisco and Vacaville, and San Mateo, San Francisco, North San Diego and Solano Counties, CA, as well as organizations serving individuals in Washington County, Oregon and Jefferson County, Kentucky.

Funding Requirements

The Genentech Foundation will consider solicited and unsolicited grant requests from nonprofits and governmental organizations to support a charitable, educational or scientific purpose aligned with our mission and focus areas.

In order to be eligible for a Genentech Foundation grant, your organization must not be:

- A political or sectarian organization
- Based outside of the United States

In order to be eligible for a Genentech Foundation grant, the funding must not be used for:

- Alumni drives
- · Capital campaigns/building funds
- Infrastructural requests (e.g. salaries, equipment)
- Individuals
- Memorial Funds
- Professional sports events or athletes
- Religious purposes
- Scholarships
- Yearbooks

In addition, the Foundation will not fund proposals that pose a conflict of interest with the commercial goals of Genentech or any officers within the Foundation board of directors. This includes activities that influence the sale, distribution or development of a Genentech product.

The Genentech Foundation is committed to the underlying beliefs and enforcement of its non-discrimination policy. As such, the Foundation does not support organizations, which, in their constitution or practice, discriminate against a person or group on the basis of:

- Age
- Political Affiliation
- Race
- National origin
- Ethnicity
- Gender
- Disability
- Sexual orientation
- · Religious beliefs

The level of funding and the duration of grants are solely determined at the discretion of the Foundation Board of Directors. Each year, the Foundation receives hundreds of grant proposals. While it is not possible to fund every application, those that are in alignment with the Foundation's mission and guidelines are given careful consideration.



How to Apply

Submit your application online. The Foundation will review applications to ensure they fit with our focus areas and mission. Foundation staff conduct due diligence on the application and the organization, and we may request further information during our review process. We review applications on a quarterly basis. Below are the 2015 submission deadlines.

- January 31, 2015
- April 15, 2015
- July 1, 2015
- September 15, 2015

Funding requests must be submitted online through the <u>Genentech Funding</u> <u>Request System</u>.
