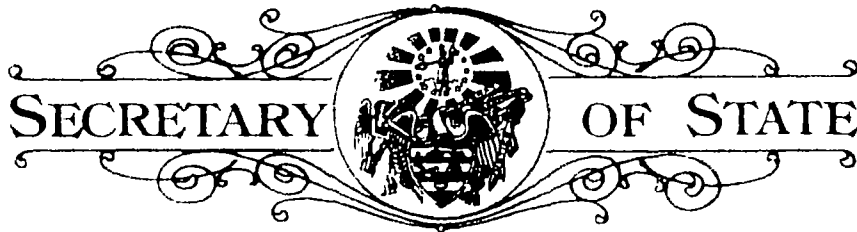

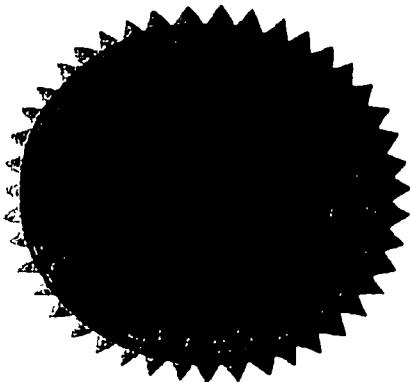

The principal office of ALOTIAN CHARITIES, INC. (formerly WESTERN AMATEUR 2013 INC.) ("**Corporation**") in the State of Arkansas shall be located in the City of Little Rock, County of Pulaski. The Corporation may have such other offices, either within or without the State of Arkansas, as the Board of Directors of the Corporation ("**Board**") may designate or as the business of the Corporation may require from time to time.

**ARTICLE II. BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

SECTION 1. General Powers. The affairs, activities and operation of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board. The Board shall have the duty to see that the purposes of the Corporation, as set forth in the Articles of Incorporation, as amended and restated from time to time, are furthered and accomplished to the best of its ability.

SECTION 2. Number and Tenure. The number of directors of the Corporation (hereinafter referred to collectively as "**Directors**" or individually as "**Director**") shall be set by the Board at its annual meeting, but in any event such number shall not be fewer than three (3). Except for the initial Directors named in the Articles of Incorporation or designated by the incorporator, all other Directors shall be elected by the Board at its annual meeting. Except as provided in the Articles of Incorporation or designated by the incorporator, each Director shall hold office for a term of three (3) years. Each Director shall hold office until the earliest of the expiration of such Director's term, or such Director's death, incapacity, resignation or removal in the manner hereinafter provided. A Director may serve one (1) or more subsequent terms by reelection.

SECTION 3. Annual Meeting. An annual meeting of the Board shall be held at a time and place established by resolution of the Board for the purpose of electing Directors, a Chairperson of the Board ("**Chairperson**"), a Vice-Chairperson of the Board ("**Vice-Chairperson**") and officers, if any, of the Corporation, and for the transaction of such other business as may come before the meeting. If the election of Directors, Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and officers of the Corporation shall not be held at such meeting, or at any reconvened meeting thereof, the Board shall cause the election to be held at a special meeting of

the Board as soon thereafter as is convenient. The time and place of any additional regular meetings may be fixed by resolution of the Board. If the day fixed for a regular meeting shall be a legal holiday in the State of Arkansas, such meeting shall be held on the next succeeding business day. Such regular meetings may be held without notice other than such resolution fixing the time and place of such meetings.

SECTION 4. Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Board may be called by or at the request of any Director or the President. The Director or the President calling such special meeting of the Board may fix the time and place for holding such special meeting of the Board.

SECTION 5. Notice. Notice of any special meeting shall be given at least three (3) days previously thereto by written notice delivered personally, mailed, e-mailed, texted or faxed to each Director at such Director's business address or e-mail address, or by text or facsimile transmission. If mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the United States mail addressed to such Director's business address on record with the Secretary, with postage thereon prepaid. If e-mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when transmitted to such Director's e-mail address on record with the Secretary. If notice is given by text or facsimile transmission, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered upon transmission to such Director's text or facsimile number on record with the Secretary. Each Director is responsible for delivering and updating such Director's current business address, e-mail address and text or facsimile number in the records maintained by the Secretary and informing the Secretary as to such Director's preferred method for receiving notices. Any Director may waive notice of any meeting. The attendance of a Director at a meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except where a Director attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

SECTION 6. Quorum. A majority of the number of Directors currently serving in such position shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board, but if less than such majority is present at a meeting, a majority of the Directors present may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice. At any reconvened meeting at which a quorum shall be present, any business may be transacted which might have been transacted at the meeting as originally notified.

SECTION 7. Manner of Acting. Except as otherwise provided herein, the affirmative vote of a majority of the Directors present at a meeting when a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board. Upon disclosure of the material facts of a transaction and a Director's interest therein, a Conflict of Interest Transaction may be authorized, approved or ratified if it receives the affirmative vote of a majority of the Directors then in office who have no direct or indirect interest in the transaction. However, a Conflict of Interest Transaction may not be authorized, approved

or ratified by less than a majority of the entire Board. A "Conflict of Interest Transaction" is a transaction with the Corporation in which a Director has a direct or indirect interest. For purposes of this Section a Director has an indirect interest in a transaction: (a) if the Director has a material interest in an entity that has a direct interest; or (b) the Director is a general partner in a partnership, a manager of a limited liability company, or a director, officer or trustee of another entity that has a direct interest. The Board may impose additional requirements on Conflict of Interest Transactions by a resolution adopting a Conflict of Interest Policy.

SECTION 8. Action Without A Meeting. Any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board may be taken without a meeting if the action is taken by all Directors. The action must be evidenced by one (1) or more written consents describing the action taken, signed by each Director, and included in the minutes filed with the corporate records reflecting the action taken. Any action taken under this Section shall be effective when the last Director has signed the consent, unless the consent specifies a different effective date, which effective date shall control. A consent delivered by text or facsimile transmission or other electronic means with an image of the Director's signature shall constitute a valid signed consent. A consent signed under this Section has the effect of a meeting vote and may be described as such in any document.

SECTION 9. Telephonic Meetings Permitted. A Director may participate in a meeting of the Board or any committee by means of conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can simultaneously hear each other, and participation in a meeting pursuant to this Section shall constitute presence in person at such meeting.

SECTION 10. Resignation of Directors. A Director may resign at any time effective upon written notice of such resignation to the Chairperson.

SECTION 11. Removal of Directors. A Director may be removed with or without cause by the vote of a majority of the Directors present at a meeting which is called for the purpose of removing a Director and for which the meeting notice states that the purpose, or one of the purposes, of the meeting is removal of that Director. The Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson may be removed with or without cause by the vote of a majority of the Directors present at a meeting which is called for the purpose of removing the Chairperson and/or Vice-Chairperson and for which the meeting notice states that the purpose, or one of the purposes, of the meeting is removal of the Chairperson and/or Vice-Chairperson.

SECTION 12. Vacancies. Any vacancy of a Director, Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson may be filled by the affirmative vote of a majority of the remaining Directors though less than a

quorum of the Board. A Director, Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson elected to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of such predecessor in office or until the selection, nomination and confirmation of a successor in accordance with these Bylaws, whichever occurs first. Any directorship to be filled by reason of an increase in the number of Directors may be filled by election by the Board for a term of office continuing only until the next election of Directors, if such election is not part of the annual meeting.

SECTION 13. Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson. The Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson shall hold such office for a term of one (1) year; provided, the Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson shall hold office until such successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified, or, if earlier, until such person's death, incapacity, resignation or removal. The Chairperson shall preside at all meetings thereof, and in the Chairperson's absence the Vice-Chairperson shall preside. The Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson shall also serve on the Executive Committee as more fully set forth hereinbelow.

### **ARTICLE III. OFFICERS**

SECTION 1. Number. The officers of the Corporation may be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, each of whom shall be elected by the Board. Such other officers and assistant officers as may be deemed necessary may be elected or appointed by the Board. The number and identity of the officers shall be set by the Board at its annual meeting. The same individual may simultaneously hold more than one (1) office in the Corporation. At any time a President is not elected, the Chairperson shall assume all powers and duties of the President. At any time a Vice-President, Secretary or Treasurer is not elected, the Vice-Chairperson shall assume all powers and duties of such officer or officers. In addition the Board from time to time may appoint agents of the Corporation. The appointment of an agent of the Corporation must be approved by the Board acting in any manner permitted under these Bylaws.

SECTION 2. Term of Office. Each officer shall hold office for a term of one (1) year; provided, each officer shall hold office until such officer's successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified, or, if earlier, until such officer's death, incapacity, resignation or removal in the manner hereinafter provided.

SECTION 3. Resignation of Officers and Agents. An officer or agent of the Corporation may resign at any time upon at least thirty (30) days' prior written notice of such resignation to the Chairperson.

SECTION 4. Removal of Officers and Agents. An officer or agent of the Corporation may be removed with or without cause by the vote of a majority of the Directors present at a meeting which is called for the purpose of removing an officer or agent and for which the meeting notice states that the purpose, or one of the purposes, of the meeting is removal of that officer or agent. Any notice required to be given in this Article shall be subject to the provisions of Section 5 of ARTICLE II.

SECTION 5. Vacancies. Any vacancy occurring in any office may be filled by the Board. An officer elected to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of such predecessor in office or until the selection, nomination and confirmation of a successor in accordance with these Bylaws, whichever occurs first. Any office to be filled by reason of an increase in the number of offices may be filled by election by the Board for a term of office continuing only until the next election by the Directors.

SECTION 6. President. The President may be a Director and shall be the principal executive officer of the Corporation, subject to the control of the Board, and in general, shall supervise and control all of the business and affairs of the Corporation. The President may sign, with the Secretary or any other proper officer of the Corporation thereunto authorized by the Board, any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the Board has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Board or by these Bylaws to some other officer or agent of the Corporation, or shall be required by law to be otherwise signed or executed, and the President shall in general perform all duties as may be prescribed by the Board from time to time.

SECTION 7. Vice-President. In the absence of the President or in the event of the President's death, inability or refusal to act, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President, and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President. The Vice-President shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to the Vice-President by the President or by the Board.

SECTION 8. Secretary. The Secretary, or its designee, shall: (a) keep the minutes of the proceedings of the Board in one or more books provided for that purpose; (b) see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws or as required by law; and (c) in general, perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to the Secretary by the President or by the Board.

SECTION 9. Treasurer. The Treasurer shall: (a) have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds of the Corporation; (b) receive and give receipts for moneys due and payable to the Corporation from any source whatsoever, and deposit all such moneys in the name



of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as shall be selected by the Board; (c) provide a report on the financial condition of the Corporation at the annual meeting of the Board and at such other times as may be requested by the Board; and (d) in general, perform all of the duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to the Treasurer by the President or by the Board. If required by the Board, the Treasurer shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of the Treasurer's duties in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the Board shall determine.

#### **ARTICLE IV. COMMITTEES**

SECTION 1. Establishment. The Board from time to time may establish, instruct, and discharge one or more committees of the Board. A committee may be established either as a standing committee or as an ad hoc committee for a special purpose. Subject to Article X, each committee established by the Board shall consist of two (2) or more Directors each of whom shall serve at the pleasure of the Board. The creation of each committee and the appointment of members shall be approved by the Board acting in any manner permitted under these Bylaws.

SECTION 2. Powers. The Board may delegate such of its powers as it deems necessary to such committees as it may from time to time establish; provided, however, a committee of the Board may not: (a) authorize distributions; (b) approve the dissolution, merger or the sale, pledge or transfer of all or substantially all of the assets of the Corporation; (c) elect, appoint or remove Directors or fill vacancies on the Board or any of its committees; or (d) adopt, amend or repeal the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws. Any committee may exercise such of the Board's authority as the committee is granted by the Board, subject to the restrictions contained in the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws.

SECTION 3. Meetings and Action. The provisions of these Bylaws that apply to the Board meetings shall also apply to govern meetings, action without meetings, notice and waiver of notice, and quorum and voting requirements of each committee and its members. Pursuant to those provisions, each committee shall elect a chair from its membership and such chair shall fix the time and place of its meetings, shall provide for the recording of minutes of committee meetings, and shall promptly report the committee's actions and recommendations to the Board. If the committee chair is unable or otherwise fails to perform those duties, the Chairperson may take such actions as are necessary to ensure that the committee's responsibilities are fulfilled, including without limitation the replacement of the committee chair.

SECTION 4. Executive Committee. There may be a standing committee to be known as the "Executive Committee." The members of the committee shall consist of the Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson and the President of the Corporation and other members appointed by the

Board. The Executive Committee may exercise the powers of the Board in the management of the business and affairs of the Corporation as allowed under the Arkansas Nonprofit Corporation Act of 1993. The Executive Committee shall maintain regular minutes of their proceedings and report the same to the Board at each regular meeting of the Board.

## **ARTICLE V. INDEMNIFICATION OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS**

SECTION 1. Mandatory Indemnification. In accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §§4-33-852 and 4-33-856, the Corporation shall indemnify any incorporator, Director or officer of the Corporation and such person's estate or personal representative who is wholly successful, on the merits or otherwise, in the defense of any proceeding to which the incorporator, Director or officer of the Corporation is a party by virtue of such person's status as an incorporator, Director or officer of the Corporation.

SECTION 2. Permissible Indemnification. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §4-33-851, and except as provided in Section 3 below, the Corporation may indemnify a Director or officer of the Corporation made a party to a proceeding by virtue of such person's status as a Director or officer of the Corporation, against liability incurred in the proceeding if the following conditions are met: (a) the Director or officer of the Corporation conducted himself or herself in good faith; (b) with respect to conduct in such person's official capacity, the Director or officer of the Corporation had reason to believe that such person's conduct was in the best interests of the Corporation; and (c) in cases of conduct not in such person's official capacity, the Director or officer of the Corporation had reason to believe that such person's conduct was at least not opposed to the best interests of the Corporation.

SECTION 3. Prohibition of Indemnification in Certain Cases. The Corporation shall not indemnify a Director or officer of the Corporation in connection with any proceeding by or in the right of the Corporation in which the Director or officer of the Corporation was adjudged liable to the Corporation, or in connection with any other proceeding charging improper personal benefit to the Director or officer of the Corporation, whether or not involving action in such person's official capacity, in which the Director or officer of the Corporation was adjudged liable on the basis that personal benefit was improperly received by the Director or officer of the Corporation.

SECTION 4. Procedure for Authorizing Indemnification of Directors. Before the Corporation may indemnify any Director pursuant to Section 2 above, a determination must be made that indemnification of a Director is permissible because the Director has met the standards of conduct set forth in Section 2 of this Article. The Board shall make that determination by a majority vote of a quorum consisting of Directors who are not at the time parties to the

proceeding; provided, however, if such a quorum cannot be obtained, the determination shall be made either by a committee designated by the Board or by special legal counsel in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §4-33-855(b)(2) and (3). Furthermore, the Corporation may not indemnify a Director until twenty (20) days after the effective date of the written notice of the proposed indemnification to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas. The Corporation may pay for or reimburse the reasonable expenses incurred by a Director or officer of the Corporation who is a party to a proceeding in advance of final disposition of the proceeding upon authorization made in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §4-33-855 and upon satisfaction of all the conditions prescribed in Ark. Code Ann. §4-33-853.

SECTION 5. Insurance. The Corporation may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of the Directors and officers of the Corporation to insure against liabilities asserted against or incurred by the Directors and officers of the Corporation in that capacity or arising from their status as Directors and officers of the Corporation, whether or not the Corporation would have the power to indemnify them against the same liability under the preceding sections of this Article.

SECTION 6. Definitions. The following definitions apply to the indemnification provisions of this Article:

(a) Proceeding. "Proceeding" means any threatened, pending or completed civil action, suit or proceeding, whether judicial, administrative, or investigative, and whether formal or informal.

(b) Liability. "Liability" means the obligation to pay a judgment, settlement, penalty, fine (including an excise tax assessed with respect to an employee benefit plan), or reasonable expenses actually incurred with respect to a proceeding.

(c) Expenses. Indemnification against expenses that is mandated or permitted under this Article is limited to reasonable expenses, including attorneys' fees, incurred in connection with a proceeding.

(d) Ark. Code Ann. All citations in these Bylaws to "Ark. Code Ann." shall refer to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated, as amended from time to time, or any successor law. Any references to specific sections of the Ark. Code Ann. shall include any subsequent amendments thereto or substitutions therefor.

(e) Code. All citations in these Bylaws to "Code" shall refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, as now existing and as amended hereafter, or any successor

federal laws, and shall also include the Treasury regulations promulgated thereunder. Any references to specific sections of the Code shall include any subsequent amendments thereto or substitutions therefor.

## **ARTICLE VI. CONTRACTS, LOANS, CHECKS, DEPOSITS & GIFTS**

SECTION 1. Contracts. The Board may authorize any officer or agent to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

SECTION 2. Loans. No loans shall be made by the Corporation to the Directors or officers of the Corporation. Any Directors who vote for or assent to the making of a loan to a Director or officer of the Corporation, and any officer or officers participating in the making of such loan, shall be jointly and severally liable to the Corporation for the amount of such loan until repayment thereof in accordance with the provisions of the Arkansas Nonprofit Corporation Act of 1993. No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the Corporation and no evidences of indebtedness shall be issued in its name unless authorized by a resolution of the Board. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

SECTION 3. Checks, Drafts, Etc. All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Corporation shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents of the Corporation and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board.

SECTION 4. Deposits. All funds of the Corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board may select.

SECTION 5. Gifts. The Board may accept or reject on behalf of the Corporation any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for the general purposes or for any specific purpose of the Corporation. The Board may establish and receive funds dedicated to segregated accounts for various specific purposes, as determined by the Board from time to time. Amounts received and/or allocated to any segregated account shall be used only for such specific purposes identified by the Board upon the funding or the creation of such segregated account, unless such purpose no longer exists or is feasible. Examples, but not a limitation, of such segregated accounts that the Board may establish are accounts for endowment, building and facilities and scholarships.

## **ARTICLE VII. FISCAL YEAR**

The fiscal year of the Corporation shall begin on the first day of January and end on the last day of December in each year.

## **ARTICLE VIII. DIVIDENDS PROHIBITED**

The Corporation shall not have or issue shares of stock, and no dividend shall be paid and no part of the income of the Corporation shall be distributed to the Directors or officers of the Corporation. The Corporation may pay compensation in a reasonable amount to a Director, officer, agent or employee of the Corporation for services rendered, and may reimburse a Director, officer, agent or employee of the Corporation for expenses incurred in attending to their authorized duties; provided, however, such expenses shall be evidenced by receipt or other proper document.

## **ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENTS**

These Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed and new Bylaws may be adopted by the Board at any regular or special meeting of the Board; provided, however, unless the amendments are unanimously adopted by action without a meeting pursuant to these Bylaws or unless notice is waived, the Corporation shall provide seven (7) days' prior written notice to the Directors that the amendment will be voted upon at the meeting, and the notice must state that the purpose, or one of the purposes, of the meeting is to consider the proposed amendment of these Bylaws, and the notice shall also contain or be accompanied by a copy or a summary of the amendment or state the general nature of the amendment. Any amendment must be approved by a majority of the Directors in office at the time the amendment is adopted.

## **ARTICLE X. FINANCIAL AID**

SECTION 1. Selection. The Corporation may make distributions to be applied as financial aid, scholarship, tuition assistance or other similar aid for students from time to time ("Scholarship(s)"). Any Scholarship program conducted by the Corporation shall be administered in the following manner:

(a) Board or Committee's Actions. The recipients of Scholarships shall be selected by the Board (provided, a Director shall not participate in any vote that possibly could benefit the Director, directly or indirectly); provided, however, the Board from time to time may establish, instruct, and discharge a Scholarship Committee, either as a standing committee or as an ad hoc committee. The Board may delegate such of its powers as it deems necessary to such Scholarship Committee as it may from time to time establish. The Scholarship Committee may

exercise such of the Board's authority as the Scholarship Committee is granted by the Board, subject to the restrictions contained in the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws.

(b) Recipients. In selecting Scholarship recipients, the Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, may make its selections upon the following criteria: (i) financial need, (ii) academic merit, (iii) leadership potential as demonstrated by extra-curricular achievements, and (iv) recommendations from instructors. In selecting Scholarship recipients, the Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, shall not discriminate on the basis of race, gender or national origin, and such awards shall be on an objective basis.

(c) Number and Amount of Awards. The number of Scholarships awarded and the amount of each Scholarship award shall be determined in the sole and absolute discretion of the Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be. The Board shall annually review the principal and income of the Corporation and shall determine how many Scholarship recipients the Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, may select and in what amounts the Scholarships will be awarded. To the extent practicable, the Scholarship awards shall be paid by the Corporation directly to the educational entity.

(d) Renewal. Any Scholarship award may be renewed, in the sole and absolute discretion of the Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, to a Scholarship recipient from semester to semester only if:

(i) Such Scholarship recipient continues to meet the requirements for study or training at an educational entity;

(ii) The Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, has no information indicating that the original grant is being used for any purpose other than that for which it was made;

(iii) Any reports due at the time of the renewal decision pursuant to the terms of the original grant have been furnished; and

(iv) Any additional criteria and procedures for renewal are objective and non-discriminatory.

(e) Supervision. The Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, shall exercise proper supervision over the progress of the Scholarship recipients in order to insure that the Scholarship funds are being used in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. With respect to any Scholarship award that is not paid directly to the educational entity, the Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, shall take all reasonable and appropriate steps to recover funds which are determined upon proper investigation to have been spent for other than the intended purposes. The Board or Scholarship Committee, as the case may be, shall permanently retain the following information in compliance with any pertinent Treasury Regulations:

(i) The identity of each Scholarship recipient and the amount of each Scholarship awarded;

(ii) All written information received in relation to the consideration and selection of Scholarship recipients; and

(iii) Any reports furnished by each educational entity with respect to each student who has received a Scholarship.

SECTION 2. Restrictions.

(a) No Benefit. No Director, member of the Scholarship Committee or disqualified person (as defined in §4946 of the Code) ("**Disqualified Person**") shall be in a position to derive a private benefit, directly or indirectly, in the selection of Scholarship recipients, and in furtherance of such policy, no Director, member of the Scholarship Committee or Disqualified Person shall participate in any decision to award a Scholarship where a person related to such Director, member of the Scholarship Committee or Disqualified Person is a potential recipient.

(b) Company-Sponsored Program. At any time a Scholarship program is considered a company-sponsored scholarship program, then the following additional restrictions shall apply notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in these Bylaws:

(i) No Inducement. Any Scholarship program must not be used to recruit employees or to induce employees to continue employment with regard to any Director, member of the Scholarship Committee, Disqualified Person or related company.

(ii) Scholarship Committee. A Scholarship Committee must be established and made up of independent individuals (independent of the Corporation and the related company). Scholarship Committee members should be knowledgeable in education. The Scholarship Committee must be allowed to vary the amount of the awards and the awards must be made by the Corporation in the order recommended by the Scholarship Committee. The Corporation may reduce but not increase the number of Scholarships determined by the Scholarship Committee to be awarded. Only the Corporation or the Scholarship Committee may publically announce the awards. Any related company newsletter may publicize the awards so long as it clearly identifies the Corporation as the grantor of the awards.

(iii) Minimum Eligibility Requirements. Individuals awarded Scholarships must meet minimum admission standards of an educational entity and must reasonably be expected to attend an educational entity. The related company may require that the employee be employed for up to three (3) years to be eligible. The related company may not put any other restrictions on eligibility.

(iv) Objective Standards of Selection. Selections standards must be unrelated to employment.


(v) Employment. Renewal of an award must not be contingent on remaining an employee. Renewal must be based on nonemployment criteria.

(vi) Course of Study. Awards cannot be limited to those students taking courses that would particularly benefit the Corporation or the related company. The recipient must be free to choose any course of study.

(vii) Other Objectives. The Scholarship program must be consistent with the disinterested purpose of enabling individuals to obtain an education solely for their personal benefits.
