zingrights. In 2014 we were members of a statewide coalition to raise the minimum wage. This campaign w	vas successful and in raising the
minimum wage has improved the lived fr over 365,000 low wage workers and their families.	
Grant funds recieved has now allowed us to hire on two staff organizers and open/maintain an office space	e to continue our work in 2014.
Hiring staff has allowed us to expand our organizing efforts, began to build a membership base, and devel	lop strong relationships with
other community organizations.

In late 2014 our organization was provided a grant opportunity to engage members in our community to pa	articipate in the 2014 elections.
We were operating totally nonpartisan. Our sole objective was to get people registered to vote, advised the	em of where they could find info,
helped locate their polling place, and get them connected to the process. To carry out the requirements of	this grant we hired two temporary
staff organizers. Through door knocking efforts, presentations, and tabling at events we were able to engage	age with over 400 community
members. We registered 69 new voters and on Election Day provided rides to 21 people who needed trans	portation to their polling place.
This grant opportunity also allowed us to build a base for our organization and provided some initial fundi	ing for our office site and supplies.
70% of the individuals we connected with during the campaign were low wage workers and/or people of co	olor.
