ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF UCARE FOUNDATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317A, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be UCare Foundation.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND POWERS

- 1. The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, as contemplated and permitted by Sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"). Within the framework and limitations of the foregoing, the purposes for which the Corporation is formed, and the business and the objects to be carried on and promoted by it, are as follows: to promote the health of the residents of the communities served by UCare Minnesota, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation. In carrying out its purposes, the Corporation shall at all times be organized and operated exclusively to act for the benefit of, perform the functions of, and carry out the purposes of UCare Minnesota, all within the meaning of Code Section 509(a)(3).
- 2. The Corporation may receive gifts and bequests and hold, administer, and dispose of the same exclusively for the accomplishment of the charitable purposes for which the Corporation was created. The Corporation in carrying out its purposes shall have all the powers granted by law to a corporation formed under the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317A, as amended.
- 3. Notwithstanding any provision herein, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Code Section 501(c)(3).
- 4. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except to the extent permitted by law, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE III NO PRIVATE INUREMENT

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private individual, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.

ARTICLE IV DURATION

The period of duration of corporate existence of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V REGISTERED OFFICE

The location of the registered office of the Corporation in the State of Minnesota shall be:

500 Stinson Boulevard NE Minneapolis, Minnesota 55413

ARTICLE VI SOLE MEMBER

The sole member of the Corporation shall be UCare Minnesota.

ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- 1. The general management of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors. The number, qualifications, term of office, method of election, powers, authorities, and duties of the Directors, the time and place of their meetings, and such other provisions with respect to them as are not inconsistent with the express provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, shall be as specified in the Bylaws of the Corporation.
- 2. Any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting by written action signed by the number of Directors that would be required to take the same action at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which all Directors were present; provided that when the action is taken by less than all Directors, all Directors must be notified immediately of its text and effective date. The written action shall be effective when signed by the required number of Directors, unless a different effective time is provided in the written action. Failure to provide the notice does not invalidate the written action. A Director who does not sign or consent to the written action is not liable for the action.

ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, distribute the assets of the Corporation to UCare Minnesota if such corporation is then qualified for tax exemption as an organization described in Code Section 501(c)(3). In the event UCare Minnesota is not then qualified for tax exemption, the Board of Directors shall distribute the remaining assets of the Corporation to such organization or organizations as the Board may determine which are exempt from federal tax under the Internal Revenue Code. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the district court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, nothing herein shall be construed to affect the disposition of property and assets held by the Corporation upon trust or other condition, or subject to any executory or special limitation, and such property, upon dissolution of the Corporation, shall be transferred in accordance with the trust, condition or limitation imposed with respect to it.

BYLAWS OF UCARE FOUNDATION

ARTICLE 1 - OFFICES

- 1.1 <u>Registered Office</u>. The principal office of this corporation shall be at 500 Stinson Boulevard Northeast, Minneapolis, Minnesota, or such other address as the Board of Directors may as time to time determine.
- 1.2 Other Offices. The corporation may have such other offices, within or without the State of Minnesota, as the Board of Directors shall from time to time determine.

ARTICLE 2 - MEMBER

- 2.1 <u>Corporate Member</u>. The sole member of this corporation is UCare Minnesota, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation ("Member").
- 2.2 <u>Member Rights</u>. In addition to any other rights reserved to the Member by this corporation's Articles of Incorporation or by these Bylaws, all powers afforded to voting members of nonprofit corporations shall be vested solely and exclusively in the Member. The Member shall vote or otherwise act through its board of directors or any person designated by its board of directors.

ARTICLE 3 - DIRECTORS

- 3.1 <u>General Powers</u>. The business, property and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of the Board of Directors. The Board shall have all powers that may be exercised by the corporation.
- 3.2 <u>Number, Qualifications and Election</u>. The Board of Directors shall consist of such number of directors as may be determined by the Member from time to time.
 - 3.3 Terms. Each director shall serve for a term established by the Member.
- 3.4 <u>Removal</u>. Any elected or appointed director may be removed from office with or without cause by the Member.
- 3.5 <u>Resignation</u>. Any director may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Chair of the Board or the Secretary. Such resignation shall take effect without acceptance upon receipt of the notice, unless a later date is specified in the notice.
 - 3.6 <u>Vacancies</u>. Vacancies in the Board of Directors shall be filled by the Member.
- 3.7 <u>Board Meetings</u>. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be conducted as described below.

- 3.7.1 <u>Regular Meetings</u>. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at such time and place as may be fixed by resolution adopted by a majority of the entire Board of Directors.
- 3.7.2 <u>Special Meetings</u>. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at such time and place as may be designated in a notice or waiver of notice of the meeting. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by the Chair of the Board, the President and Chief Executive Officer, or by written petition signed by any two directors and delivered to the Secretary. Notice of a special meeting (including a statement of the purposes for the meeting) shall be given to each director at least 24 hours in advance if the notice is oral or two days in advance if the notice is written.
- 3.7.3 <u>Meetings by Remote Communication</u>. Directors may participate in meetings of the Board of Directors by means of a conference telephone or similar remote communication equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can communicate with each other, which participation shall constitute presence in person at the meeting. Meetings may occur solely by means of remote communication under Minnesota Statutes, Section 317A.231.
- 3.7.4 Notice. Except as otherwise provided in these Bylaws, notice of Board meetings shall be made by giving written notice not less than five nor more than 30 days prior to the meeting. The notice shall be given to all directors and shall state the date, time and place of the meeting. The notice should, but need not, state the purposes of the meeting, unless otherwise required by law or these Bylaws. Written notice may be given by mail, courier, or facsimile transmission delivered to the address maintained for each director in the records of the corporation. Notice may also be provided by electronic mail when directed to an electronic mail address at which a director has consented to receive notice, or by other electronic communication by which a director has consented to receive notice. When oral notice is permitted, it may be given by telephone or in person. If a meeting schedule is adopted by resolution of the Board, or if the date and time of a Board meeting has been announced at a previous meeting, additional notice should, but need not, be given, and no director may object to such meeting on the grounds of failure to provide timely notice.
- 3.7.5 <u>Waiver of Notice</u>. A director may waive notice of any meeting before, at or after the meeting, in writing, orally or by attendance. Attendance at a meeting by a director is a waiver of notice of that meeting unless the director objects at the beginning of the meeting to the transaction of business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened, and does not participate thereafter in the meeting. All waivers of notice shall be filed with the records of the corporation.
- 3.8 Action Without a Meeting. Any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors may be taken by written action signed, or consented to by authenticated electronic communication, by that number of directors that would be required to take the same action at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which all directors are present.
- 3.9 **Quorum: Voting.** The presence of a majority of the Board of Directors in office at the time of the meeting shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. A meeting at

which a quorum is initially present may continue to transact business until adjournment, despite the withdrawal of a number of directors such that fewer than a quorum remain; provided, however, that any action taken thereafter must be approved by at least a majority of the required quorum for the meeting or by such greater number as may be required under the law, the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws. In the absence of a quorum, a majority of the directors present may adjourn a meeting until a quorum is present. Except as otherwise required under the law, the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws, the acts of a majority of the directors present at a duly held meeting shall be the acts of the Board of Directors.

3.10 <u>Compensation</u>. Directors shall receive no compensation for their services as directors, except as may otherwise be determined by resolution of a majority of the entire Board of Directors. Directors may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses, but only as determined from time to time by resolution of the Board of Directors. This shall not be construed to preclude any director from serving the corporation in any other capacity and receiving appropriate compensation for his or her services.

ARTICLE 4 - OFFICERS

- 4.1 <u>General</u>. The corporation shall have a Chair, a Vice Chair, a President and Chief Executive Officer, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The Board may elect or appoint such other officers as it deems necessary. Any of the offices or functions may be held or exercised by the same person. Officers may receive compensation for their services and reimbursement for their expenses as determined from time to time by the Board.
- 4.2 <u>Election: Term of Office: Oualifications</u>. The officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors and shall serve terms as provided by resolution adopted by the Board. Each officer shall hold office until his or her successor has been duly elected and qualified, or until the earlier death, resignation, retirement, termination or other removal of the officer. Except as otherwise provided in these Bylaws, officers need not be directors of the corporation.
- Chair of the Board. The Chair shall (a) preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors; (b) be generally responsible for all matters of protocol of the Board of Directors; and (c) preside at all meetings of the Executive Committee. If the Chair is not present at a meeting of the Board or the Executive Committee, the Vice Chair shall preside at the meeting. If the Chair later joins the meeting, he or she shall preside from the point of his or her arrival.
- 4.4 <u>Vice Chair of the Board</u>. The Vice Chair shall assist and serve in the absence of the Chair, and shall preside at all meetings of the Board and the Executive Committee in the absence of the Chair.
- 4.5 <u>President and Chief Executive Officer</u>. Unless provided otherwise by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, the President and Chief Executive Officer shall (a) have general active management of the business of the corporation; (b) preside at meetings of the Board of Directors and the Executive Committee in the absence of the Chair and the Vice Chair; (c) see that all orders and resolutions of the Board are carried into effect; (d) sign and deliver in the name of the corporation any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts or other instruments pertaining to the business of the corporation, except in cases in which the authority to sign and

deliver is required by law to be exercised by another person or is expressly delegated to some other officer, employee or agent of the corporation; (e) maintain records of and, when necessary as an alternate to the Secretary, certify proceedings of the Board, its committees or the members of the corporation; and (f) perform all duties incident to the office of the President and Chief Executive Officer and such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board. The President and Chief Executive Officer may delegate duties as provided in Section 4.12.

- 4.6 <u>Secretary</u>. Unless provided otherwise by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, the Secretary shall (a) be secretary of and attend all meetings of the Board of Directors; (b) record the proceedings of the meetings in the minute book of the corporation; (c) give notices as required by these Bylaws; and (d) perform such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Chair, the President and Chief Executive Officer or the Board of Directors. The Secretary may delegate duties as provided in Section 4.12.
- Treasurer. Unless provided otherwise by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall (a) keep accurate financial records for the corporation; (b) deposit all monies, drafts and checks in the name of and to the credit of the corporation in such banks and depositories as the Board of Directors shall designate from time to time; (c) endorse for deposit all notes, checks and drafts received by the corporation as ordered by the Board, making proper vouchers therefore; (d) disburse corporate funds and issue checks and drafts in the name of the corporation, as ordered by the Board; (e) render to the Chair, the President and Chief Executive Officer and the Board of Directors, whenever requested, an account of all of his or her transactions as treasurer and of the financial condition of the corporation; and (f) perform such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by Chair, the President and Chief Executive Officer or the Board of Directors. The Treasurer may delegate duties as provided in Section 4.12.
- 4.8 <u>Removal</u>. Any officer elected or appointed by the Board of Directors may be removed, with or without cause, upon a vote of not less than 75% of those directors present at a meeting duly called and held by the Board of Directors. The Board may take such action whenever in its judgment the best interests of the corporation would be served thereby, but the removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the person removed.
- 4.9 Resignation. Any officer may resign at any time by giving written notice to the corporation. The resignation is effective when notice is given to the corporation, unless a later date is specified in the notice; provided, however, the Board may elect to make the resignation effective at an earlier date. Acceptance of the resignation is not necessary to make it effective.
- 4.10 <u>Vacancies</u>. A vacancy in any elective office because of death, resignation, removal or otherwise may be filled by the Member or the Board of Directors for the unexpired term.
- 4.11 Other Officers. Any other officers appointed by the Board of Directors shall perform such duties and be responsible for such functions as the Board of Directors may prescribe.
- 4.12 Delegation of Duties. Unless prohibited under the law, the Articles of Incorporation, these Bylaws or any resolution adopted by the Board, an officer may delegate

some or all of his or her duties and powers to other persons. An officer who delegates the duties and powers of his or her office remains subject to the standard of conduct for an officer with respect to the discharge of the delegated duties and powers.

4.13 <u>Standard of Conduct</u>. An officer shall discharge the duties of his or her office in good faith, in a manner he or she reasonably believes to be in the best interest of the corporation, and with the care an ordinarily prudent person in a like position would exercise under similar circumstances.

ARTICLE 5 - COMMITTEES

- 5.1 Executive Committee. The Member shall appoint an Executive Committee comprised of five members of the Board. The Chair of the Board shall be a member of, and shall chair, the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall have and exercise the authority of the Board in the management of the business of the corporation, except with respect to matters requiring approval of greater than a majority of the directors and except as otherwise limited by the Board. The Executive Committee shall act only in the interval between meetings of the Board and shall be subject at all times to the control and direction of the Board.
- 5.2 <u>Finance and Audit Committee</u>. The Member shall appoint a Finance and Audit Committee, and shall designate a director among the members to chair the committee. The Finance and Audit Committee shall oversee the financial affairs of the corporation, including external and internal audits. The committee's responsibilities shall include: review of the corporation's financial statements, oversight of the corporation's investment policy, including compliance with that policy; general oversight of the corporation's financial reporting obligations; hiring and overseeing the external financial auditor; and reviewing the results of audits by regulatory agencies and the external financial auditor, and of internal audits addressing appropriate financial controls and compliance with financial or tax-exempt regulations, including reviewing the corporation's response to such audits.
- 5.3 The UCare Fund Council. The Member shall appoint individuals to serve as the UCare Fund Council, and shall designate a member to chair the Council. The primary duty of the UCare Fund Council shall be to make determinations on the expenditure or other distribution of funds of the corporation.
- 5.4 <u>Committees in General</u>. The Member or Board of Directors may appoint such other committees as it may deem proper and shall prescribe the functions and membership of each such committee. Each committee, including those described above in this Article 5, shall be subject to the control and direction of the Board.

ARTICLE 6 - INDEMNIFICATION: CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

6.1 <u>Conflicts of Interest</u>. Minnesota Statutes, Section 317A.251 requires that directors of nonprofit corporations discharge their duties in good faith and with that diligence and care which an ordinarily prudent person in a like position would exercise under similar circumstances. Directors, officers, committee members and management staff have a duty to serve the corporation with diligence and loyalty, including the maintenance of confidentiality

with respect to corporate business and interests, and to act honestly, in good faith, and in the best interests of the corporation.

The varied interests, backgrounds and representative roles of the directors, officers and committee members, and the potentially varied interests of management staff, may result in circumstances that might be viewed as possible conflicts of interest. A duality of interest or possible conflict of interest shall be considered through full disclosure of such interest and diligent efforts to clarify the extent to which a director, officer, committee member or management staff member is acting in his or her respective role with the corporation. The Board of Directors shall adopt a conflict of interest resolution or policy to provide guidance to the directors, officers, committee members and management staff in disclosing and resolving possible conflicts of interest in the performance of their duties on behalf of the corporation.

- 6.2 <u>Indemnification</u>. The corporation shall indemnify such persons, for such expenses and liabilities, in such manner, under such circumstances, and to such extent as is permitted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 317A.521, as now enacted or hereafter amended.
- 6.3 <u>Standard of Conduct</u>. Each director and officer shall discharge his or her duties as a director or officer in good faith, in a manner which the director or officer reasonably believes to be in the best interests of the corporation, and with the care an ordinarily prudent person in a like position would exercise under similar circumstances.

ARTICLE 7 - FINANCIAL REPORTING

- 7.1 Owarterly Report. The Board of Directors shall be provided with regular reports, no less than quarterly, as to the financial status and activities of the corporation.
- 7.2 Annual Andit. The Board shall cause the records and books of account of this corporation to be audited by an independent certified public accounting firm at least once each fiscal year and at such other times as it may deem appropriate.

ARTICLE 8 - AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be amended in the manner provided by the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, provided the resolution of amendment has been adopted by a two-thirds majority vote of all the directors.
