	Environmental Demand Response Research Program - This program involves WattTime directly conducting research and analysis of power grids, to develop software tools to calculate what times electricity is more or less environmentally friendly. (Sharing these tools
	with the public to enable the more environmentally friendly use of electricity then happens through our Education and Assistance
	programs.) In 2014 we made very significant research progress. Specifically, we: (1) developed a piece of software that
	automatically analyzes the approximate cleanliness of electricity in real time for any point in the continental United States; (2) developed a second software tool (known as an Application Programming Interface) that can share this information with other
	software developers to help them design equipment that shifts energy use to cleaner times; and (3) began research on a set of
	algorithms that could allow us to analyze more precise and sophisticated information about the cleanliness of electricity. Software
	development took place at a mixture of occasional weekend "hackathons" in which large groups of volunteers would collaborate on
	development, and more consistent progress by a smaller core of volunteers.

-	environmental harm by shifting electricity use to particular times. (Enabling the public to act on that awareness happens through our Research and Assistance programs.) In 2014 we made progress on education. Specifically, we: (1) Built a software tool on our website
	which allows people to see in real time the environmental impact of electricity in their region (you can see the tool at
	http://api.WattTime.org/map). (2) Maintained a software service which sent daily text messages to any interested users (there were
	approximately 50 by the end of 2014) about the cleanest time that day to use energy. (3) Spoke about the issue by giving 14
	interviews to the press, and speaking with approximately 10 energy interest groups and classrooms on how time-shifting can reduce
	environmental harm. (4) Showed over a dozen other software developers how they can write software applications to reduce
	environmental harm using our Application Programming Interface. (5) Developed a set of information to answer common questions about the impact of time shifting to reduce environmental harm through time-shifting. (6) Spoke and gathered feedback from over 20
	other energy experts and 300 other Americans about time-shifting and their needs and interests around the topic.

	that automatically charge the cars at cleaner times; and (2) Begin a very similar project at the University of California, Berkeley.
