THE FOUNDATION MAKES GRANTS TO EXEMPT ORGANIZATIONS ONLY AND REQUESTS A COPY OF THE ORGANIZATION EXEMPTION RULING LETTER AND THE PRESENT STATUS OF THE EXEMPT ORGANIZATION. GRANTS TO INDIVIDUALS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
