The Pathology Honor Society is organized at the level of each participating medical school with the chair of the Department of Pathology, or designee, assigned responsibility for execution of the program. Specific activities remain the purview of each individual medical school.

Student members are selected by the Department of Pathology at each participating school of medicine on the basis of the following criteria:

- 1. Scholastic achievement in the pathology curriculum
- 2. Research accomplishments as a medical undergraduate
- 3. Leadership potential, as evidenced by activities as a medical undergraduate
- 4. Overall excellence, with potential to develop further academically.

Please note that it is recommended that the number of nominated students be no larger than 10% of the class size; however, it is permissible to include up to 20% of the class.
