	HSLC is an animal welfare organization serving Loudoun County and surrounding areas since 1966 with the mission of creating a No- Kill community (save a minimum of 90% of the animals entering the county shelter). This is accomplished by implementing a proven
	comprehensive strategy which includes strong Foster/Adoption programs, low cost Spay/Neuter, Pet Retention, Trap-Neuter-Return,
	Medical Rehabilitation, Lost & Found, Community Involvement, Compassionate Mgmt, and Partnerships with other Animal Rescues.

	Foster/Adoption Program: Two key components of the No-Kill Equation that are closely related are: Foster Care and Comprehensive
	Adoption programs. For reporting purposes, these two programs are consolidated, with the Foster component incurring the
	expenses and the Adoption program generating revenue. Expenses for the Foster program consist primarily of veterinarian fees
	(83%) with the balance spent on boarding, food, and basic pet supplies. Revenue is generated by applying for grants and by charging
	a nominal Adoption Fee for dogs and cats. One grant was awarded for this program in 2014 to offset the medical expenses of a
	severely injured young dog. It is the mission of the Foster Program to provide temporary shelter, quality medical care, and a
	nurturing environment to abandoned and abused animals who are waiting for permanent placement into loving homes through the
	Adoption Program.
	In 2014, HSLC assumed new responsibility for 117 animals, including 32 cats & 8 dogs which were transferred out of tax payer funded
	facilities. Many of the animals have special needs due to neglect and lack of adequate medical care.
	By year end 2014, 109 animals had been successfully adopted and 7 were reclaimed by their owners.
