

Applicants must be in the upper 50 percent of their high school graduating class and must score at least 1000 on the S.A.T. or comparable on the ACT or ASSET. Preference will be given to applicants who are residents of Lancaster County School District, Fort Mill School District #4, and Chester County School District. Students must maintain at least a 2.75 grade point average and full-time enrollment as defined by the college.

Loans are made on the basis of financial need. This is determined by information obtained from the Financial Aid Office of the school to be attended. Loans to undergraduate students may not exceed \$14,000 over a four-year period. Loans to medical school and dental school students may not exceed \$18,000 over a four-year period. Students who have been in the undergraduate program may apply for loans for medical and dental school.

Grants

The Foundation reviews grant applications from organizations for merit eligibility and priority status in the Fort Mill, South Carolina office. Additional data is requested from applicants when necessary. Recommendations are then presented to the Board of Directors for approval. The Foundation sometimes initiates programs and grant actions but most often takes a responsive posture. Programs are often established on a matching basis with government, another foundation or the sponsoring agency as the other participant.

Grants are made primarily in Lancaster County, Chester Township of Chester County and Fort Mill Township of York County. They are made in the fields of 1. recreation and environment, 2. public education and early childhood development, 3. community service and health, and 4. Emergency and Critical Need (Temporary Focus).

Funds are distributed in grants as they are available and in accordance with the pay-out provisions of the tax laws.
