Bradley-Turner Foundation, Inc. ("BTF") and Beloco Foundation, Inc. ("Beloco"), pursuant to Treas. Reg. § 53.4945-5(b)(3), hereby agree to the following terms with respect to a grant from BTF to Beloco payable during BTF's tax year ending December 31, 2014:

1. Use of Funds. BTF will provide to Beloco, subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement, a grant of \$ 134,332. The purpose of the grant from BTF is for the funds to be added to the capital endowment of Beloco and for the funds (and the income therefrom) to be used for the charitable grant-making purposes of Beloco. (c) Make an individual grant or re-grant funds to another organization unless the requirements of section 4945 of the Code are met; or

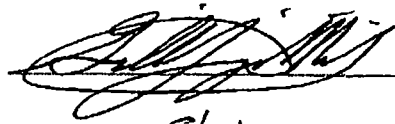

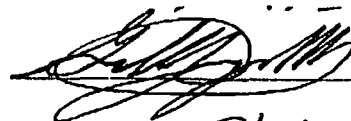

The Bradley-Turner Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation," which includes the Stephen T. Butler Family Fund, C.C. and Sarah T. Butler Fund, Elizabeth Ramsay Family Fund, Lovick P. and Elizabeth T. Corn Fund, and W. B. and Sue T. Turner Fund) has approved a grant to The Hughston Foundation, Inc. ("Hughston") in the amount of \$40,000, subject to the conditions below. Because Hughston and the Foundation are both private foundations, the grant is made in accordance with the expenditure responsibility rules of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). Please sign two copies of this Grant Contract, return one copy to the Foundation with a copy of Hughston's determination letter from the IRS, and retain the other copy for your files. Execution of this Grant Contract by a person authorized to bind Hughston acknowledges its acceptance of the following Grant terms:

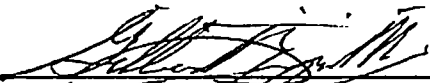
1. Funds paid pursuant to the Grant and any income earned thereon shall be used exclusively for the purposes of the Hughston Athletic Training Fellowship Program, to include the payment of any of the Program's expenses, such as (but not limited to) the payment of tuition, fees and stipends of the Fellows and defraying the expenses incurred in having the Fellows obtain training and experience through providing sports medicine care (with proper supervisory assistance) for high school athletes in the Muscogee County School District as well as coverage for Manchester High School, Greenville High School, Harris County High School, Smith's Station High School, Calvary Baptist, and Chattahoochee Valley Community College, as well as support for the research projects of the Fellows. Hughston agrees that neither the purposes for which the Grant funds may be expended nor the manner in which the Grant funds may be used will be altered without the prior written consent of the Foundation.
2. This Grant Contract shall terminate and all further expenditures of the Grant by Hughston shall cease if it fails to meet any obligations or perform any requirements under this Grant Contract. In such event, Hughston shall immediately return any unexpended portion of the Grant to the Foundation, regardless of any claimed adverse effect on the programs or operations of Hughston.
3. All Grant funds must be used exclusively for charitable purposes in accordance with all applicable federal and state laws, rulings and regulations. Any Grant funds disbursed by Hughston to individuals shall meet the requirements of section 4945(g)(1) of the Code.
4. Grant funds and any income earned thereon shall not be used:
 - A. To carry on propaganda, or otherwise to attempt to influence legislation, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Code;
 - B. To participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Code; or

- C. To make any grants to individuals or organizations (unless approved in writing by the Foundation), except that grants to the fellows that meet the requirements of section 4945(g)(1) of the Code are permitted.
5. Hughston will at all times it holds any of the Grant funds continue to be recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as an organization exempt from taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the Code and as a private operating foundation within the meaning of section 4942(j) of the Code. Any organizational or operational changes by Hughston that reasonably could be expected to affect its exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Code, including any changes that could result in a change in its classification (e.g., a change from private operating foundation classification to private grant making foundation) must be promptly reported to the Foundation in writing.
 6. Following the year in which the Grant is made and until the Grant funds received by Hughston and all income earned thereon have been expended, Hughston shall submit a full and complete annual written report to the Foundation not later than March 1 of each calendar year, setting forth information on: (a) the use of the Grant funds, including property or services purchased with the Grant funds or grants made to individuals that meet the requirements of section 4945(g)(1) of the Code, and the portion of the Grant funds received that have not been expended by the end of the preceding calendar year; (b) Hughston's compliance with the terms of the Grant; (c) the progress made by Hughston towards achieving the purposes for which the Grant was made, and (d) the most recent annual financial statement of Hughston. Hughston's reporting obligation to the Foundation shall survive the termination of this Grant Contract, regardless of the reason therefor.
 7. Hughston will account for its use of Grant funds as a pro rata part of its overall expenditures relating to the Athletic Training Fellowship Program, and make its books, records and personnel available to the Foundation and its agents at reasonable times for purposes of confirming the uses of the Grant funds. Hughston will retain its records regarding the use of the Grant funds and copies of the reports provided pursuant to section 6 hereof no less than four (4) years following the close of Hughston's annual accounting period during which the use of the Grant funds is completed.
 8. Hughston agrees to use its best efforts to comply with all applicable requirements of the USA Patriot Act and Executive Order 13224, and all subsequently enacted legislation, executive orders, or regulations, designed to prevent any Grant funds from being used in support of terrorism or a terrorist organization.
 9. Public announcements of the Grant may be made by Hughston and the Foundation. Any written materials printed with funds from the Grant should acknowledge the support of the Foundation. Hughston will provide the Foundation with prior written notice of any reference to the Foundation in its written materials, and will give the Foundation an opportunity to approve any such references; such approval not to be unreasonably withheld. Copies of all such materials are to be submitted to the Foundation at least fourteen (14) days before such approval is required to be received, and final copies of such written materials must be included with Hughston's next written report to the Foundation.

10. No part of the Grant funds shall be paid to any Foundation official, and Hughston acknowledges that no gifts or services were or will be rendered to the Foundation or any Foundation official in exchange for this Grant.
11. Hughston will notify the Foundation immediately in the event that any of the following occur:
- A. It is unable to use any portion of the Grant funds for the intended purposes;
 - B. It is unable to comply with any of the terms of this Grant Contract; or
 - C. Any grant funds are used in a manner inconsistent with the terms of this Grant Contract.
12. The Foundation reserves the right to:
- A. Withhold any payments provided for under this Grant, recover from Hughston any unexpended Grant funds and to require restitution by Hughston of any previously expended Grant funds, if the terms of this Grant Contract (other than those of paragraph 9) are violated by Hughston;
 - B. Require Hughston to take reasonable precautions to prevent any diversion of Grant funds; and
 - C. Withhold any applicable taxes from any Grant payments.
13. Subject to Hughston's compliance with the terms of this Grant Contract, the payment of the Grant funds has or will be made on May 19, 2014. Both parties acknowledge that while the Grant has been stated in the even amount of \$40,000, because the Foundation often satisfies pledges with publicly traded securities, the exact amounts delivered may vary slightly from the stated Grant amount. Hughston shall be responsible under this Grant Contract only for the amounts actually delivered to it.
14. This Grant Contract is not assignable by either party or transferable by operation of law or otherwise.
