The laws of the United States applicable to Charitable Trusts also require that certain restrictions be placed upon the use of grant funds and certain reporting and record keeping requirements be imposed upon grant recipients. Thus, the grant is subject to the restrictions enumerated below, and is made upon the condition that Grantee comply with the reporting and record keeping requirements enumberated below. 1.
