The Applicant is requesting a change in method of accounting under section 10.11 of the Appendix of Rev. Proc. 2011-14, as modified by Rev. Proc. 2014-16, to change its method of accounting to deduct incidental material and supply costs in taxable year amounts are paid.

The types of incidental material and supply costs to which this change applies are described below and are hereinafter collectively referred to as "material and supply costs." Typical examples of such costs include, but are not limited to, the following:

Under the present method of accounting, the Applicant has deducted materials and supplies hat do not fall under the category of inventory in the year paid.

#### Page 3, Part II, Line 12c, Proposed Method of Accounting

Under the proposed method of accounting, the Applicant will change the method of accounting to deduct amounts paid or incurred for repair and maintenance in accordance with Reg. section 1.162-4. Reg. section 1.162-4(a) provides that a taxpayer may deduct amounts paid for repairs and maintenance to tangible property if the amounts paid are not otherwise required to be capitalized.

Under the proposed method of accounting, the Applicant will change the method of accounting to deduct amounts paid or incurred for routine maintenance in accordance with Reg. section 1.162-4. Reg. section 1.162-4(i) provides that amounts paid for routine maintenance to tangible property is deemed not to improve the unit of property.

Under the proposed method of accounting, the Applicant will change the method of accounting to capitalize amounts paid or incurred for repair and maintenance in accordance with Reg. section 1.263(a)-3. Reg. section 1.263(a)-3 provides that a taxpayer may capitalize amounts paid for repairs and maintenance to tangible property as amounts paid to improve property if expenditures are not otherwise required to be deducted.

Under the proposed method of accounting, the Applicant will change the unit of property for all real property to the building system components. For personal property the Applicant will change the unity of property determination based on functional interdependence and/or discrete and major functions unless industry specific guidance is published.
