strengthen the ministries of the United Methodist Church. The Foundation provides a method for faithful stewards to leive out their
discipleship in ways that extend beyond their own lifetime. The Foundation profides services to churches and institutions by managing
investment funds, creating and building permanent endowment funds, developing planned giving and education resources and investmen
management services.
The Foundation also assists with many different kinds of gifts to enhance the ministry of Arkansas United Methodist individuals, church
