Need is determined by consideration of annual family income, number of family members, unusual family expenses and the possibility of attending college without scholarship aid. Project Opportunity is aimed at those students who are unlikely candidates for post-secondary training without intervention within the educational process. Intervention will create an awareness of career opportunities available to individuals and assist in the development of a vision for the future for those students. Mentors provide guidance for students from the point of entry into the program through high school graduation. The Project Opportunity Foundation provides financial aid to allow a student who qualifies to attend Weatherford College. Qualifying students are awarded a full two year Weatherford College Scholarship for tuition, books and fees up to a maximum of \$5,000 per student. Scholarships awarded to students average about 20 per year. Project Opportunity Foundation periodically meets with school superintendents, principals and college administrators, interviews scholarship applicants, and monitors recipients progress throughout the two year program. Students with difficulties are reevaluated and assistance is provided to enable them to complete their education. Project Opportunity Scholarship recipients are recognized upon graduation at graduation Ceremonies. All work is done by directors and others on a volunteer basis allowing Project Opportunity Foundation to focus it's resources on providing scholarships to needy students.
