Montana Conservation Voters Education Fund's primary exempt purpose is to provide research and public education to the members of conservation and environmental organizations in Montana, and other interested Montanans to protect Montana's clean air and water, wildlife, forests and open space. MCVEF seeks a more informed, educated and empowered conservation and environmental community in Montana, who takes part in this state's democratic process.

#### Form 990, Part III, Line 4a - Program Service Accomplishments

Conservation Policy Program: At the state level, MCVEF had a robust public policy and public education program related to the 2013-2014 Montana State Legislative Interim and leading up to the 2015 legislature. MCVEF accomplished a favorable report on the Montana Renewable Energy Standard, now in its 10th year; MCVEF was involved in policy analysis of the RES, which was being evaluated by policy makers, and participated in the meetings and hearings to present information on the impact of the RES on rates, reduction in carbon pollution and jobs.

Another state priority was to assess the impact of a proposal to transfer federal lands to the state, being studied by the Environmental Quality Council. MCVEF provided policy analysis, distributed public information, coordinated 2 media stories, prepared briefing materials and facilitated comments to the EQC. MCVEF was responsible for generating over three dozen comments to the EQC, as well as letters to the editor.

MCVEF's largest research and public education priority was to conduct a non-partisan public interest research survey on a range of conservation and environmental issues,

organizations, was conducted in early July, 2014 and released in late July. It was widely distributed in August - November at a total of 19 meetings attended by 131 people, including environmental group leaders, policy makers and citizen advocates.

A grant of \$25,000 was provided to Montana Conservation Voters for public policy services, including analysis of state legislative proposals; preparation and distribution of briefing papers; coordination of three meetings with allied conservation and environmental groups; and coordination of 7 meetings with state policy makers in 7 communities, attended by MCVEF also conducted meetings with officials of the administration of Governor Steve Bullock in its policy analysis work.

At the federal level, MCVEF coordinated the Climate Action Coalition and Clean Air Campaign, working in partnership with the national League of Conservation Voters Education Fund and over a dozen conservation, public health and fish and wildlife groups. The key focus was to assess the proposed EPA rule to reduce carbon emissions in the United States by 30% by 2030. MCVEF worked to educate citizens, local and statewide decision makers on the impacts of climate change and the EPA rule on public health, fish and wildlife and a clean energy future, and to ensure the authority of the Environmental Protection Agency to protect public health under the Clean Air Act, including from the negative impact of carbon emissions. MCVEF leaders were part of letters to the editor and guest commentaries, and attended over a dozen meetings and events on the Clean Air Act, climate change and the Production Tax Credit.

Additionally, MCVEF sponsored or co-sponsored thirteen meetings and events throughout 2014, and reached out to legislative, statewide and local officials to engage them in this dialogue as well. MCVEF also led the campaign to generate nearly 16,000

comments from Montana on the proposed EPA rule.

Montana Conservation Voters Education Fund continued its work on safe chemicals in the first half of 2014 by coordinating two press events aimed at elevating the importance of reducing toxic chemicals in household products. MCVEF leaders worked to educate the public and local decision makers about the re-authorization of the federal Toxics Substances and Control Act (TSCA) and proposals to ensure greater safety in household products and chemicals. MCVEF partners with the national League of Conservation Voters Education Fund and the Safe Chemicals Coalition on this campaign.

MCVEF Non-partisan Civic Engagement and Ballot Measure: This project evaluated the impacts of policy proposals affecting voter rights and voter registration, pertaining to LR126, a ballot measure that would have repealed the right to register to vote on election day and the day before. MCVEF conducted online and mailed public education programs on the ballot measure and helped in its defeated (categorized as a direct lobby expense), working with the ballot committee "Montanans for Free and Fair Elections." MCVEF also convened a meeting with the Montana Secretary of State and coordinated earned media on LR126 including a Public News Service Story.

MCVEF's signature "Non-Partisan Civic Engagement Program" had a banner year, by registering 1,283 voters (mainly low and moderate income women, Native Americans and those not affiliated with conservation groups) using a non-partisan mailer in

partnership with the national Civic Engagement Project. MCVEF also conducted a program to enroll people as absentee ballots, sending a mailer to nearly 26,000 of whom 19 percent responded, an incredible participation rate. This increased participation in the 2014 election from amongst low propensity voters. MCVEF met with county election officials to discuss ways to improve election procedures and encouraged them to increase the number of drop boxes for returned ballots at convenient locations.

Leadership and Staff Development: MCVEF's signature "Conservation Leadership Project" used its "Ladder of Engagement" to reach out to citizens to encourage them to attend leadership trainings and take part in MCVEF's LR126 campaign described below. February, MCVEF held two workshops featuring the Alliance for Justice, which brought together 33 and 51 people, respectively, from a range of non-profit groups. MCVEF also conducted a fall training featuring Andy Robinson on fundraising and financial management, attended by 24 MCVEF leaders and staff. MCVEF also conducted a robust internal staff development program for its new Program Director and Program Associate. The trainings were held monthly from January - April, 2013. One Board member attended the LCV/LCVEF annual meeting, one attended the 2014 citizen activist day in June with LCVEF, and two staff and one board member attended a summer, 2014 fundraising training.

Community Organizing, Outreach and List Enhancement: In 2014, MCVEF worked with allies to visit with citizens at their doors, over the phone, and to write letters to the editor on the proposal to repeal Montana's election day voter registration. MCVEF knocked 12,921 doors, spoke with nearly 4,000 citizens at the door, and conducted a follow up phone canvass to discuss voter rights in the fall of 2014, resulting in a total of 9,865 direct contacts with voters. In follow up, MCVEF included these individuals in a non-partisan Civic Engagement Program, described below and continued to reach out to them in late 2014 to provide information on how to be involved in the 2015 legislature.

MCVEF coordinated the Billings Conservation Roundtable and the Missoula Conservation Roundtable, which convened network gatherings held 9 times throughout the year as a public service to conservation and environmental groups in those communities. Attendance at the Roundtables ranged from a low of 5 to a higher of 30, with an average attendance of 16 in Billings and 11 in Missoula. MCVEF's outreach program also included periodic participation in the Great Falls Conservation Roundtable and the Flathead Conservation Roundtable during the year. MCVEF's outreach program in 2014 included participation in the Montana Voices non-partisan collaborative, bringing together groups that work on civic engagement and progressive public policy. MCVEF staff also did one on one visits with partners in the Conservation Working Group, a statewide coalition working on environmental policy.

MCVEF changed its List Project in 2014 wherein the lists were acquired in late 2014 and enhanced with important demographic and jurisdictional information. In the fall, the project aided mailings to a coalition of group members to attend gatherings about clean air and climate change (featured in MCVEF's conservation
