The Nelson Museum of the West maintains a continuous and bona fide program for solicitation of funds from the general public.

The Museum sends an average of four (4) letters of solicitation per work day to Cheyenne Wyoming residents and businesses. The Museum also sends two/three letters per day to members of the United States Military soliciting in-kind donations of military uniforms and accessories.

The Board of Directors of this museum represents the Interests of the public. Board members includes attorneys, a rancher, retired military and businessmen.

The Museum is open each year from May through October for the public and opens at other times during the year for school groups or special interest groups. The Museum has provided its facilities for weddings, reunions, receptions, U.S. Cavairy Association members, Boys & Girls Club members, YMCA groups and various tours.
