Completed application - Two letters of recommendation - Letter of acceptance - Personal statement - An official transcript - Current photoA student must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits for post secondary and a graduate student must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credits each semester. In order to remain in good standing they must complete 12 or 9 credits respectively with at least a 2.0 GPA. Working students are those who are working in the Norton Sound Region. These students are funded based on the amount of credits they are taking. Because they are a working student, they do not need to take classes full-time and there is no deadline for those students.
