

The DeMund Foundation was created in 1947 by the late Herman E. DeMund and his wife, Ruth K. DeMund primarily for the purpose of granting to deserving students financial assistance through scholarships and grants. The foundation, since its inception, has primarily directed its educational grants to three Arizona universities - University of Arizona, Arizona State University and Northern Arizona University - and to Albright College, where Mrs. DeMund's father was president for many years.

Individual scholarship grants are awarded by the institutions on the basis of merit and need, as determined by the scholarship committee, and are not available to relatives of the foundation's trustees. Individual applications can only be submitted through proper channels at the institutions.
