EXPLANATION OF AMENDED RETURN:

THE 2014 RETURN AS ORIGINALLY FILED INCLUDED \$1,483 OF REIMBURSEMENTS FOR OVERHEAD EXPENSES PAID TO SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTORS (AND THUS DISQUALIFIED PERSONS). IT WAS DETERMINED DURING THE PREPARATION OF THE 2015 RETURN THAT THESE PAYMENTS COULD BE CONSIDERED TO CONSTITUTE ACTS OF SELF-DEALING (THOUGH NOT ACTS KNOWINGLY PARTICIPATED IN BY FOUNDATION MANAGERS).

ACCORDINGLY, THE \$1,483 HAS BEEN RECLASSIFIED AS NONDEDUCTIBLE EXPENSES, RESULTING IN CHANGES AS FOLLOWS:

PART I, LINE 13, HAS BEEN INCREASED \$27,881 TO \$27,881 TO REFLECT A RECLASSIFICATION OF EXPENSES FROM LINE 23 (THESE AMOUNTS ARE ALSO REPORTED ON PART VIII, LINE 1).

PART I, LINE 23, HAS BEEN REDUCED \$27,881 TO \$121,084 FOR RECLASSIFICATION NOTED ABOVE. IN ADDITION, LINE 23, COLUMN B HAS BEEN REDUCED \$927 TO \$3,997, REFLECTING \$880 RECLASSIFIED TO LINE 13, COLUMN B, AND \$47 CONSIDERED NONDEDUCTIBLE. IN ADDITION, LINE 23, COLUMN D, HAS BEEN REDUCED \$28,437 TO \$115,380, REFLECTING \$27,001 RECLASSIFIED TO LINE 13, COLUMN D, AND \$1,436 CONSIDERED NONDEDUCTIBLE.
