The Seattle Contract Bridge League is a 501(c)(7) corporation.

Our purpose is social and recreational. We organize and conduct duplicate bridge tournaments in King County, WA.

We are a local unit of a North American organization, the American Contract Bridge League.

Our tournaments (about five a year) consist of competition in duplicate bridge. While this is a card game, our tournaments are not "gaming" events. No money is wagered. The winners receive no cash or anything of monetary value. Instead, they are awarded and accumulate "master points," which establish skill levels for a local and national rating system.

We charge an entry fee for participating in our tournaments. We have reported the total of these entry fees during during 2014 on Line 2, as "Program Service Revenue."

We rent venues for these tournaments, and have reported the rental cost and janitorial fees on Line 14.

We incur various other expenses in conducting these tournaments, e.g., food and non-alcoholic drink, payment to our parent organization to compensate the tournament directors, transportation of equipment and supplies, and other costs. We have reported all of these costs on Line 16, along with various other costs of our operations. These include liability insurance, a laptop computer, and other smaller costs.
