THE HARKAVY-MACK FAMILY FOUNDATION TRUST AGREEMENT

THIS IS AN AGREEMENT by and between CARIN BEA HARKAVY
MACK, as Trustor, and CARIN BEA HARKAVY MACK, SARAH ELIZABETH
MACK and EMILY TOBA MACK, as Trustee, made the day of
, 2001 ("the Agreement").

Trustor has irrevocably transferred to the Trustee the property listed on Schedule A attached hereto, which property, together with any additions thereto by Trustor or any other persons or entities ("Foundation property") the Trustee shall hold, administer and distribute as hereinafter provided. This trust shall be known as the "The Harkavy-Mack Family Foundation" (hereinafter the "Foundation").

- 2. PURPOSES: The Foundation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code") ("charitable purposes"), and the Foundation property shall be used exclusively for such charitable purposes. The Foundation shall make charitable contributions, within the meaning of Code Section 170(c)(2)(B), and qualifying distributions, as described in section 5 below and within the meaning of Code Section 4942(g) ("qualifying distributions"), out of its net income, its assets or both, to the "qualifying beneficiaries" described in section 7 below.
- 2. <u>DURATION OF FOUNDATION</u>: The Trust shall be perpetual, but the Trustee may terminate the trust at any time by distributing all of the Foundation property to such organizations described in Code Section 501(c)(3) and exempt from

taxation under Code Section 501(a) as shall carry out the Foundation's charitable . purposes.

- 3. <u>DESIGNATION OF TRUSTEES</u>: The initial Trustees of the Foundation shall be CARIN BEA HARKAVY MACK, SARAH ELIZABETH MACK and EMILY TOBA MACK. The initial Trustees may at any time add additional Trustees and may designate Successor Trustees without court proceedings. If all of the initial Trustees become unable or unwilling to serve as Trustee and there would otherwise be a vacancy in the position of Trustee, the last serving Trustee shall designate in writing an individual and/or corporate Trustee to serve as Successor Trustee without court proceedings.
- eligible beneficiaries and to assist in the determination of the amounts to be paid over to them, may, but shall not be required to, appoint an advisory committee not to exceed five (5) persons. The members of the advisory committee shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for their reasonable expenses. Members of the advisory committee may be selected from business and professional men and women, educators, and individuals of similar stature. The Trustee shall not be required to follow the recommendations of the advisory committee.

5. **QUALIFYING DISTRIBUTIONS**:

5.1 Qualifying Distributions: The Trustee may from time to time make distributions from income or principal of the trust within the limitations of Code Section 4942(g) and as hereinafter set forth, to or for the use of such qualifying

beneficiaries defined in section 7 below and for such charitable purposes as set forth .
above.

5.2 <u>Limitations</u>:

- (a) No part of the net earnings of the Foundation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any individual so as to jeopardize the Foundation's exempt status under Code Section 501(c)(3). The Foundation shall be authorized and empowered, however, to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, to make reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred on its behalf, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the Foundation's charitable purposes.
- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the Foundation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as may be allowed Code Section 501(c)(3) organizations; and the Foundation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Agreement, the Foundation shall not conduct or carry on activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization described in Code Section 501(c)(3) and exempt from taxation under Code Section 501(a), or by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Code Section 170(c)(2).
- (d) If the Foundation is, or at any time becomes, a private foundation within the meaning of Code Section 509, for as long as such private

foundation status continues, the following provisions shall apply in the management of its affairs:

- (i) The Foundation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Code Section 4942;
- (ii) The Foundation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Code Section 4941(d);
- (iii) The Foundation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Code Section 4943(c) which would subject the Foundation to tax under Code Section 4943;
- (iv) The Foundation shall not make any investments or otherwise acquire assets in such manner as to subject it to tax under Code

 Section 4944; and
- (v) The Foundation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Code Section 4945(d).
- 6. <u>FINAL DISTRIBUTION</u>: Upon the winding up and dissolution of the Foundation and subject to the provisions of section 5, and after payment of or adequate provision for the debts and obligations of the Foundation, the Trustee shall distribute the Foundation property to such organizations described in Code Section 501(c)(3) and exempt from taxation under Code Section 501(a) as shall carry out the Foundation's charitable purposes. In no event shall any of the Foundation property

be distributed to or for the benefit of any private individual other than as reasonable .

- 7. **QUALIFYING BENEFICIARIES**: For purposes of this Trust Agreement, "qualifying beneficiaries" shall mean:
- 7.1 Section 501(c)(3)/509(a)(1), (2) or (3) Public Charities or Exempt Operating Foundations: Organizations which are described in Code Section 501(c)(3); are either Section 509(a)(1), (2) or (3) public charities or exempt operating foundations, as described in Code Section 4940(d)(2); and are exempt from taxation under Code Section 501(a);
- 7.2 <u>Foreign Section 501(c)(3) Equivalents</u>: Foreign equivalents of United States Code Sections 501(c)(3)/509(a)(1), (2) or (3) public charities pursuant to Revenue Procedure 92-94, as amended;
- 7.3 <u>Individuals</u>: Individuals chosen on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis pursuant to the requirements of Code Section 4945(g) and the Treasury Regulations thereunder;
- 7.4 <u>Private Operating Foundation</u>: During any period in which the Foundation qualifies as an "operating foundation" under Code Section 4942(j)(3), those members of the general public benefited by the Foundation's active conduct of the activities constituting the Foundation's charitable purposes;
- 7.5 <u>Expenditure Responsibility Grants</u>: Those United Statessitus organizations to whom the Foundation make grants over which it exercises expenditure responsibility pursuant to Code Section 4945(h);
- 7.6 Expenditure Responsibility Grants to Foreign
 Organizations: Those non-United States-situs organizations to whom the Foundation makes grants over which it exercises expenditure responsibility pursuant to Code Section 4945(h), subject to the limitations imposed by Treasury Regulations Sections 53.4945-5(b)(5) and 53.4945-6(c)(2)(ii), as amended;
- 7.7 <u>Program-Related Investments</u>: Those United States-situs organizations a loan to which or investment in which is a program-related investment as defined in Code Section 4944(c); is a grant made exclusively for charitable purposes, as defined in Treasury Regulations Sections 53.4945-4(a)(2) and 53.4945-6(c)(1)(i), as amended; and over which the Foundation exercises expenditure responsibility pursuant to Treasury Regulation Section 53.4945-5(b)(4), as amended;

- 7.8 Program-Related Investment to Foreign Entities: Those non-United States-situs organizations a loan to which or investment in which is a program-related investment as defined in Code Section 4944(c); is a grant made exclusively for charitable purposes, as defined in Treasury Regulations Sections 53.4945-4(a)(2) and 52.04945-6(c), as amended; and over which the Foundation exercises expenditure responsibility pursuant to Treasury Regulation Section 53.4945-5(b)(4), subject to the limitations imposed by Treasury Regulation Section 53.4945(b)(5), as amended;
- 7.9 Governmental Entities for Charitable Purposes: The Federal government, or one or more state or local governments (or political subdivision(s) thereof), exclusively for charitable purposes; and
- 7.10 <u>Foreign Governmental Entities for Charitable Purposes</u>: A Foreign government designated by Executive Order Under 22 U.S.C. 288, as superseded or amended (or political subdivision(s) thereof), exclusively for charitable purposes.

8. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS:

- 8.1 <u>Accounting of Prior Trustee</u>: A Co-Trustee or Successor Trustee may accept a predecessor's accounting without independent review or audit and shall not be liable for any loss sustained during or attributable to the period in which a predecessor served as Trustee.
- 8.2 <u>Trustee's Compensation</u>: A corporate Trustee shall be compensated for its services in accordance with its customary schedule of fees. It is Trustor's intent that the individual Trustees other than Trustor also receive reasonable compensation for services performed. In determining the amount of the compensation, consideration should be given to the time spent by the individual Trustees in carrying out their duties, the responsibility assumed by the Trustees and the amount of compensation that would be paid to a corporate Trustee under similar circumstances.
- 8.3 <u>Trustee's Powers</u>: In addition to and not in limitation of the powers set forth in this instrument, the Trustee shall have all rights, powers and duties given by law. If any powers herein conferred upon the Trustee by state law or by the terms of this instrument should jeopardize the tax-exempt status of the trust, however, this Trust Agreement shall automatically be amended to conform to the appropriate federal tax law and such offending powers shall be null and void. In addition, the Trustee shall have full power and authority:
- 8.3.1 <u>Determination of Principal and Income</u>: To determine what is principal or income, which authority shall specifically include the right to make adjustments between principal and income for premiums, discounts, depreciation

or depletion; in making such determination the Trustees may, but shall not be required to, apply the Washington Principal and Income Act;

- 8.3.2 <u>Agents and Attorneys</u>: To employ agents and attorneys as the Trustee thinks necessary or desirable for the proper administration of the trust or for any litigation, controversy, or uncertainty which may arise in connection with the trust, without liability for their omissions or neglect, but using reasonable care in their selection. The Trustee may hire discretionary investment managers for a fee. The Trustee may pay reasonable compensation to agents and attorneys for their services and be fully protected in relying on advice of legal counsel;
- 8.3.3 <u>Investments</u>: To invest and reinvest the trust assets as the Trustee shall determine to be prudent under circumstances then prevailing but without being limited in the character of investments by any statutory or other governmental limitation on the investment of trust funds. Nothing in this trust instrument shall be construed to restrict the Trustee from investing the trust assets in a manner which could result in the annual realization of a reasonable amount of income or gain from the sale or disposition of trust assets;
- 8.3.4 <u>Custodian Account</u>: To place all or any part of the securities at any time held by the Trustee in the care and custody of any bank, trust company, or member firm of the New York Stock Exchange or NASDAQ with no obligation while the securities are so deposited to inspect or verify the same and with no responsibility for any loss or misapplication by the bank, trust company, or firm, so long as the bank, trust company, or firm was selected and retained with reasonable care; and to have all stocks and registered securities placed in the name of the bank, trust company, or firm or in the name of its nominee; and to appoint such bank, trust company, or firm agent as attorney to collect, receive, provide receipt for, and disburse any income, and generally to perform the duties and services incident to a so-called "Custodian" account; and
- 8.3.5 <u>Contributions from Others</u>: To receive gifts, bequests, or devises to the Foundation from any person or persons at any time. The Trustee shall not, however, receive gifts, bequests, or devises made upon any terms or conditions that would conflict with the charitable purposes of the Foundation or other provisions of this trust agreement. The Trustee shall have power and authority to refuse or place restrictions or any gift proffered.
- 8.4 <u>Amendment</u>: This trust may be amended by Trustor, either by written instrument signed by Trustor during Trustor's lifetime or by Trustor's Last Will and Testament at Trustor's death. No amendment shall authorize the Trustee to administer this trust in any manner or for any purpose not permitted by a charitable organization described in Code Section 501(c)(3) and exempt from taxation under Code Section 501(a). Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Trustee shall have the power to

amend this trust in any manner required for the purposes of: (1) ensuring that the Foundation qualify and continue to qualify under the above provisions of the Code; (2) qualifying the Foundation as a supporting organization described in Code Section 509(a)(3); or (3) conforming to the requirements of a nonprofit corporation. After the death of Trustor, the Trustee shall not amend the trust so as to abrogate the charitable purposes of the Foundation.

8.5 Transfer to a Corporation or Supporting Organization:

8.5.1 <u>Corporation</u>: If it becomes advantageous to form a nonprofit corporation or if it becomes impracticable to continue the Foundation as a trust, then the Trustee may form a nonprofit corporation to carry out the purpose of the Foundation, and the trust assets may be transferred to such corporation. The nonprofit corporation shall have the same name, powers and purposes as herein provided. The Trustee then serving shall be the initial director of the corporation, and shall prescribe in the corporation's bylaws a plan for the successorship of directors.

8.5.2 <u>Supporting Organization</u>: If it becomes advantageous to qualify the Foundation as a "supporting organization" under Code Section 509(a)(3), the Trustee may amend this trust by written instrument so to qualify. The supporting organization shall have the same name and purposes as herein provided and such powers and duties as are consistent with a Code Section 509(a)(3) organization.

9. <u>LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION</u>:

liability to the Foundation for monetary damages for conduct as a Trustee, except for (i) acts or omissions that involve intentional misconduct by the Trustee; (ii) a knowing violation of law by the Trustee; (iii) voting or assenting to distributions by the Foundation in violation of this Agreement; (iv) any transaction from which the Trustee will personally receive a benefit in money, property or services to which the Trustee is not legally entitled. Any amendment to or modification of this section shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a Trustee of the Foundation existing at the time of such amendment or modification for or with respect to any acts or omissions of such Trustee occurring prior to such amendment or modification. This provision shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a Trustee for any act or omission occurring prior to the date this section becomes effective.

9.2 <u>Right to Indemnification</u>: The Foundation shall indemnify any person who was or is a party to any proceeding, whether or not brought by or in the right of the Foundation, by reason of the fact that such person is or was a Trustee of the Foundation, against all reasonable expenses incurred by the Trustee in connection with the proceeding unless the Trustee was adjudged liable on the basis that personal benefit was improperly received by the Trustee. Indemnification under this section 9, in

connection with a proceeding by or in the right of the Foundation, is limited to reasonable expenses incurred in connection with the proceeding.

10. MISCELLANEOUS:

- 10.1 <u>Number and Gender</u>: Unless some other meaning is apparent from the context, plurals shall include the singular and vice versa, and masculine, feminine and neuter words shall be used interchangeably.
- 10.2 <u>Section References</u>: All section references are to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, unless specifically indicated otherwise.
