Reg. §53.4945-4(d)(1) Disclosure Statement of Individual Grant-Making Procedures

Pursuant to IRC §4945(g), Reg. §53.4945-4(d)(1) and <u>Rev. Rul. 86-77</u>, 1986-1 C.B. 334, the following are the procedures of the Hawaii Emergency Physicians Education Foundation (the "Foundation") in the awarding of grants to individuals.

1. The Selection Process -- Candidates for Grants.

(a) Goal.

The Foundation's goal is to provide scholarships and grants to individuals to encourage their post-high school education.

(b) <u>Criteria</u>.

- (i) The Foundation intends to make scholarship grants to students beginning their university, college or community college studies that school year, and who is or will be a graduate from a high school in a geographical area served by Hawaii Emergency Physicians Associated, Inc. (the "Catchment Area")
- (ii) Financial need will be a primary consideration in selecting the scholarship grant recipients. Other criteria that may considered includes, but is not limited to, the following: prior academic performance; performance of each student on tests designed to measure ability and aptitude for educational work; recommendations from instructors of the student and any others who have knowledge of the student's capabilities; additional biographical information regarding a student's academic, employment, community service and other relevant experiences; and conclusions which the selection committee may draw as to the student's motivation, character, ability, or potential. Criteria may also include the student's place of residence, past or future attendance at a particular school, past or proposed course of study or evidence of the student's artistic, scientific or other special talent. Each recipient must be seriously interested in pursuing higher education.

(c) How Solicited.

The Foundation or the selection committee chosen by the Foundation will request that high schools within the Catchment Area recommend students or former students meeting the above criteria.

(d) How Selected.

The Foundation's Board of Directors, or a selection committee chosen by or under the direction of the Foundation's Board of Directors, will select the students or former students to receive the scholarship grants. Every member of any selection committee charged with the evaluation of candidates for scholarship grants will adhere to the relevant policies of the Foundation as they may be adopted and amended from time to time, including, but not limited to, conflict of interest and confidentiality policies. Every member of any selection committee charged with the evaluation of candidates for scholarship grants will be obligated to disclose any personal knowledge of and relationship with any potential grantee under consideration and to refrain from participation in the award process in a circumstance where he or she would derive, directly or indirectly, a private benefit if any potential grantee or grantees are selected over others. No grant covered by this policy may be awarded to any member of the Foundation's Board of Directors, any substantial contributor to the Foundation, any employee of the Foundation, or any other disqualified person (as defined in IRC § 4946(a)) with respect to the Foundation.

2. <u>Terms and Conditions under which the Foundation Makes Individual Grants.</u>

The terms and conditions of each scholarship grant will be contained in a letter sent to each recipient. The recipient will be required to communicate his or her acceptance thereof by a letter to the Foundation or the selection committee. The terms and conditions may include, but are not limited to, the following: specific purpose of the grant, its duration, the total amount of the grant, requirements for narrative reports and the terms of any renewal of the grant.

3. <u>Procedure for Exercising Supervision over Individual Grants.</u>

With respect to individual scholarship grants, the Foundation will arrange to receive a transcript of the recipient's courses taken and grades received for each academic period. Such transcript will be verified by the educational institution attended and will be obtained at least once a year, and prior to renewing any recipient's grant for the following academic year. Upon completion of a recipient's study at an educational institution, a final transcript will also be obtained.

The Foundation may not consider it necessary to obtain the foregoing transcript if the following conditions are met: (a) the grant is a scholarship or fellowship subject to the provisions of section 117(a) of the Internal Revenue Code and is to be used for study at an educational institution which normally maintains a regular faculty and curriculum and normally has a regularly organized body of students in attendance at the place where its educational activities are carried on; (b) the Foundation pays the scholarship or fellowship to the educational institution; and (c) the educational institution agrees to use the grant funds to defray the recipient's expenses or pay funds to the recipient only if he is enrolled at the educational institution and his standing at such institution is consistent with the purposes and conditions of the grant.

4. <u>Procedures for Investigation Where Diversion of Grant Funds from their Specified Purposes is Indicated, and for Recovery of Diverted Grant Funds.</u>

Where reports to the Foundation or other information (including failure to submit reports after a reasonable time has elapsed from their due date) indicates that all or any part of individual scholarship grant funds are not being used for the purposes of such grant, the Foundation will initiate an investigation. While conducting the investigation, the Foundation will withhold further payments to the extent possible until it has determined that no part of the grant has been used for improper purposes and until any delinquent reports have been submitted.

If the Foundation determines that any part of a grant has been used for improper purposes, the Foundation will take all reasonable and appropriate steps to recover diverted grant funds or to insure the restoration of diverted funds and the dedication of any remaining grants funds being held for the recipient to new scholarships being funded by the Foundation. These steps will include legal action unless such action would in all probability not result in the satisfaction of execution of a judgment.

If the Foundation determines that any part of the grant has been used for improper purposes and the recipient has not previously diverted grant funds to any use not in furtherance of a purpose specified in the grant, the Foundation will withhold further payments on the particular grant until:

- (i) it has received the recipient's assurances that future diversions will not occur;
- (ii) any delinquent reports have been submitted; and
- (iii) it has required the recipient to take extraordinary precaution to prevent future diversions from occurring.

If the Foundation determines that any part of the grant has been used for improper purposes and the recipient has previously diverted Foundation grant funds, the Foundation will withhold further payment until all three conditions of the preceding sentence are met and the diverted funds are in fact recovered and restored.
