BYLAWS of the GORE FAMILY MEMORIAL FOUNDATION TRUST

ARTICLE I BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 1. Trustees. The GORE FAMILY MEMORIAL FOUNDATION TRUST (GFMFT) shall be organized upon a Trust basis. The property, business, and affairs of the Trust shall be managed by its Board of Trustees and conducted in accordance with the Laws of Trust for the State of Florida and the governing rules of the Internal Revenue Service Code. No action, neither taken nor approved, shall be taken that is contrary to the State and Federal law or which will call the tax exempt status of the Trust into question. These By-laws do not supersede nor shall they be deemed in conflict with the original founding instrument of the Last Will and Testament of R. H. Gore, Sr. and all court interpretations of and amendments to that instrument.

Section 2. Number and Term of Office. The number of Trustees and their terms of office shall be as specified in the Circuit Court Case 06-5447, dated August 27, 2008 and as subsequently modified by competent authority. The Court Order, modifying Section 2 and Section 3 of Article V of the Last Will and Testament of Robert H. Gore Sr. establishing the GFMFT stands as follows:

The Trustees of my Estate shall be comprised of one individual selected from each of the families of my nine (9) children names in Section 2, Article II, hereof.

Each of the nine (9) families of my aforementioned children shall have the right to designate a Trustee by majority vote of the individual members of that family who have reached the age of 21 years and who are the most senior generation of that family. Each such Trustee must be selected from the most senior generation of such family. No individual Trustee may serve more than two (2) consecutive terms. The initial term of office shall be four (4) years for four (4) Trustees and six (6) years for five (5) Trustees, and shall be determined by lot. Thereafter, each term shall be for five (5) years.

Should the most senior generation who has reached the age of 21 years of any of the nine (9) families not be able to select their Trustee by majority vote, then that position shall remain vacant until such time that they can reach a majority vote. However, if a majority vote cannot be reached within one (1) year of the vacancy to be filled, then the next most senior generation shall be deemed to be the generation entitled to select by majority vote such Trustee from that generation. Once a generation group has been changed down, it shall not be returned up again.

When a semor generation of a descendant family has no individual able or willing to serve as Trustee, then the next generation of that descendant family shall select a Trustee from their generation.

The total number of Trustees shall not be more than nine (9), all of whom shall be direct descendants of mine. Trustee fees shall be paid to each Trustee in the amount of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00) per annum, plus reasonable expense reimbursement for traveling to the Trustee meetings. This Trustee fee shall be adjusted annually by any increase in the Consumer Price index. I hereby excuse my Executors and Trustees from giving bond.

Legal counsel, investment advisors, accountants and auditors for the Gore Family Memorial Foundation Trust shall never be a member of the Gore descendant family line or a spouse thereof.

Section 3. General Powers as to Negotiable Paper. The Board of Trustees shall, from time to time, prescribe the manner of making, signature or endorsement of checks, drafts, notes, acceptances, bills of exchange, obligations and other negotiable paper or other instruments for the payment of money and designate the officer or officers, agent or agents, who shall from time to time be authorized to make, sign or endorse the same on behalf of the Trust.

<u>Section 4. Powers as to Other Documents</u>. The Board of Trustees may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute or deliver any conveyance or other instrument in the name of the Trust, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances. When the execution of any contract, conveyance, or other instrument has been authorized without specification of the officers authorized to execute, the same may be executed on behalf of the Trust by the Chairman or Vice Chairman, and attested by the Secretary, or Treasurer.

<u>Section 5. Compensation</u>. In accordance with the Circuit Court order referenced above the Trustees shall serve at an annual compensation of NINE THOUSAND Dollars (\$9,000.00) as adjusted by the Cost of Living index beginning in 2008 and shall be reimbursed for actual, reasonable, and necessary expenses incurred by a Trustee in his or her capacity as a Trustee.

ARTICLE II MEETINGS

<u>Section 1 Meeting</u>. The meetings of the Trustees of the Trust shall be held at its office in Sea Ranch Lakes, Florida, or at such other place within or without the State of Florida as may from time to time be selected by the Trustees, quarterly in the months of February, June, September and November, or at such other time as my be selected by the Trustees for the purpose of electing or appointing Trustees and officers for the ensuing year and for the transaction of such other business as may properly be brought before the meeting.

Section 2. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the Board of Trustees may be held without notice at such times or intervals and at such places within the State of Florida as may from time

to time be determined by resolution of the Board, which resolution may authorize the Chairperson to fix the specific date and place of such regular meetings, in which case notice of the time and place of such regular meetings shall be given in the manner hereinafter provided.

<u>Section 3. Special Meetings</u>. Special meetings of the Trustees may be called by the Chairperson and shall be called by the Chairperson or Secretary at the direction of not less than two Trustees then in office, or as may otherwise be provided by law. Such meetings shall be held at the office of the Trust or electronically by telephone, internet service or video conferencing, unless otherwise directed by the Board of Trustees and stated in the notice of meeting, in which case the meeting may be held at any place within or without the State of Florida. Any request for a meeting by Trustees shall state the purpose or purposes of the proposed meeting.

Section 4. Notice of Meetings. When notice of a meeting is required by these Bylaws or by law, such notice shall contain the time, place and purpose of the meeting, shall be signed by the Chairperson or a Vice Chairperson or the Secretary, and shall be served either personally or by mail, or electronic communication systems such as e-mail upon each Trustee not less than 10 nor more than 60 days before the meeting; provided that no notice of adjourned meetings need be given. If mailed or electronically sent, the notice shall be directed to each Trustee at his or her address as it appears in the records of the Trust unless he or she shall have filed with the Secretary thereof a written request that notices intended for him or her be mailed to some other address, in which case it shall be mailed or electronically sent to the address designated in such request. Such further notice shall be given as may be required by law. Meetings may be held without notice if all Trustees are present in person or if notice of the time, place and purpose of such meeting is waived by written form, either before or after the holding thereof, by all Trustees not present at such meeting.

Section 5. Quorum. A majority of the Trustees then in office shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business and the action of a majority of the Trustees present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the action of the Board of Trustees, except as action by a majority of the Trustees then in office may be specifically required by other sections of these Bylaws. Proxy voting shall not be permitted.

Section 6. Conduct of Meetings. Meetings of the Trustees shall be presided over by the Chairperson or in his or her absence by Vice Chairperson, or Secretary of the Trust. The minutes shall be recorded by a staff member of the Trust, or in their absence by a member of the Board selected for that purpose to act as Secretary of the meeting.

Section 7. Action by Unanimous Written Consent. If and when the Trustees shall severally or collectively consent in writing to any action to be taken by the Trust either before or after the action is taken, such action shall be as valid Trust action as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the Trustees and the written consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Board of Trustees.

<u>Section 8. Telephonic Conferences</u>. A Trustee may participate in a meeting of Trustees by a conference telephone or similar communication equipment by which all persons participating in the meeting may hear each other if all participants are advised of the communications equip-

ment and the names of the participants in the conference are divulged to all participants. Participation in a meeting pursuant to this Section constitutes presence in person at the meeting. It shall be the responsibility of the Chairperson or Secretary to assure that communication with all participants is not broken or interrupted.

<u>Section 9. Voting Rules.</u> No Trustee may abstain from a vote unless he or she declares to the recording secretary a conflict or interest and provides sufficient reason to maintain that position. A failure to vote by an attending Trustee shall be recorded as an affirmative vote.

ARTICLE III OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 1. Election or Appointment. The Board of Trustees shall elect a Chairperson, a Vice Chairperson, Secretary and a Treasurer of the Trust at the Annual Meeting in even numbered years. The same person may hold no more than two offices, but no officer shall execute, acknowledge or verify any instrument in more than one capacity. The Trustees may also appoint such other officers and agents as they may deem necessary for the transaction of the business of the Trust.

Section 2. Term of Office. The term of office of all officers shall commence upon their election or appointment and shall continue for a term of two years after the initial terms established by Court Order referred to above. Officers are elected at the Annual Meeting of the Trust and serve thereafter until their respective successors are chosen or until their resignation or removal.

<u>Section 3. Removal from Office</u>. Any officer may be removed from office at any meeting of the Trustees, with or without cause, by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the nine (9) Trustees, whenever in their judgment the best interests of the Trust will be served thereby.

<u>Section 4. Resignations</u>. An officer may resign by written notice to the Trust. The resignation shall be effective upon its receipt by the Trust or at a subsequent time specified in the notice of resignation. The Trustees shall have power to fill any vacancies in any offices occurring from whatever reason. A resignation as an officer does not imply resignation as Trustee.

Section 5. The Chairperson. The Chairperson shall be responsible for overseeing the day-to-day activities of the Trust including supervision of Trust employees and the disbursement of any approved Trust funds. The Chairperson shall consult with other members of the Executive Committee, as the Chairperson deems necessary, as to matters involving the implementation of Trust policies. The Chairperson shall see that all orders and resolutions of the Board of Trustees are carried into effect. He or she shall execute all authorized conveyances, contracts, or other obligations in the name of the Trust except where required by law to be otherwise signed and executed and except where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Trustees to some other officer or agent of the Trust. He or she shall preside at all meetings of the Trustees. In his or her absence, the Vice Chairperson shall serve in this capacity. In the event the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson are not present at any meeting the Trustees present shall designate another presiding officer for the purpose of that meeting.

<u>Section 6. Vice Chairperson</u>. The Vice Chairperson shall, in the absence or disability of the Chairperson, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the Chairperson and shall perform such other duties as the Board of Trustees shall prescribe. The authorized execution by the Vice Chairperson on behalf of the Trust of any instrument shall have the same force and effect as if it were executed on behalf of the Trust by the Chairperson.

Section 7. The Secretary. The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the Board of Trustees and supervise the record of all votes and the minutes of all proceedings in a book to be kept for that purpose. In the absence of the Secretary, an acting Secretary will be appointed by the Chairperson. He or she shall give, or cause to be given, notice of all meetings of the Trustees for which notice may be required, and shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Trustees or by the Chairperson. The Secretary shall execute with the Chairperson all authorized conveyances, contracts or other obligations where required by law in the name of the Trust except as otherwise directed by the Trustees.

Section 8. The Treasurer. The Treasurer shall assure custody of the funds and securities of the Trust and shall keep full and accurate accounts of receipts and disbursements in books belonging to the Trust and shall supervise the deposit of all moneys and other valuable effects in the name and to the credit of the Trust in such depositories as may be designated by the Trustees. He or she shall disburse the funds of the Trust as may be ordered by the Trustees, taking proper vouchers for such disbursements, and shall render to the Chairperson and Trustees, at regular meetings of the Trustees, or whenever they may require it, an account of all his or her transactions as Treasurer and of the financial condition of the Trust. In performing these duties the Treasurer may use the services of financial institution, staff members, and or other agents. The Treasurer shall give no bond.

<u>Section 9. Fiduciary Responsibility</u>. All officers as well as Trustees acknowledge by the assumption of their officer that they are and serve in a fiduciary capacity and will undertake all necessary steps to keep themselves informed of this capacity.

ARTICLE IV COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

Section 1. Executive Committee. The day to day affairs of the Trust shall be conducted by the Chairperson directing the Administrative staff. As needed, the Board can restrict activity of the Chairperson to the Executive Committee. The executive committee shall be comprised of the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer, and may, at the discretion of the Executive Committee, add one additional trustee to the Committee. The Executive Committee serves a two year term and is re-appointed by Board election on the termination of the time in office of the Chairperson. There is no limit on the number of times a Trustee may serve upon the Executive Committee other than that imposed by the Trustee's term in office as a Trustee.

Section 2. Committees. The standing Committees of the Trust shall be as follows:

2.1 Grants Committee: The Grants Committee shall keep and review the ROO pertaining to the procedures and policies of awards of all grants,

scholarships, and money awards. It shall assess and recommend plans of operation for the near and far term of the Trust and identify and present opportunities for strategic participation in charitable support of persons and causes as specified by the founding documents and Trust policy.

- Finance Committee The Treasurer shall be the Chairperson of the Finance Committee, which will include not less than three Trust members. The Finance Committee shall be responsible for developing and reviewing fiscal procedures, fund raising plans, and annual budget with staff and other Trust members. The Trustees must approve the budget and all expenditures must be within the budget on an annual basis. Any major change in the budget must be approved by the Board or the Executive Committee as delegated by the Board of Trustees. The fiscal year shall begin on February 1 and end on January 31 of each year. Quarterly reports shall be submitted to the Board showing income, expenditures, and pending income. The financial records of the Trust are public information and shall be made available to the Trustees and the public.
- 2.3 <u>By-law Committee</u> The By-law Committee shall monitor, update and conform the By-laws of the Trust to any Court decision, change in State or Federal law, or where necessary to conform to the Internal Revenue Code. All such changes shall be brought to the attention of the Trustees.

<u>Section 3. Service on Committees</u>. Service for all Committees is expected to be voluntary but where required the Chairperson shall have the authority and duty to appoint Trustees to serve on such Committees. In making such appointments the Chairperson shall consider the overall development of skills and knowledge of the Trustees so that the Trust has a wide breadth of experienced Trustees.

<u>Section 4. Task Force Committees.</u> Task Force Committees (f/k/a Ad Hoc Committees) are appointed by the Chairperson and undertake such duties as the Chairperson decides. Task Force Committees terminate on the Chairperson's end of office or upon his or her discretion.

ARTICLE V INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND TRUSTEES

Section 1. Indemnification. The Trust shall indemnify and hold harmless the trustees and their legal representatives, to the extent of trust assets, from and against any loss or expense suffered or sustained by any of them by reason of the facts that she or he is or was a Trustee, or any officer or legal representative of the Trust, including; without limitations any judgment, settlement, reasonable attorney's fees and other costs and expenses incurred in connection with the defense or settlement of any actual or threatened action or proceeding provided such loss or expense did not result from willful misconduct or gross negligence on the part of such trustee and his or her officer or legal representative.

Section 2. Insurance. The Trust may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person described in section 1 against any liability (including penalties, taxes, expenses of correction, judgments, settlements or expenses) asserted against him or her and incurred by him or her in any such capacity or arising out of his or her status as such, whether or not the Trust would have the power to indemnify him or her against such liability under the provision under the provision of this article or under the provisions of Florida laws pertaining to trusts', trust accounting and uniform fiduciary accounting acts. The power of the trust to purchase and maintain insurance is discretionary but shall require a vote from the entire board of Trustees.

ARTICLE VI FISCAL YEAR NOTICES

<u>Section 1. Fiscal Year</u>. The fiscal year of the Trust shall begin on the 1st day of February of each year and shall end on the 31st day of January the following year.

Section 2. Notices. Any notice required by statute or by these Bylaws to be given to the Trustees or to any officer of the Trust, unless otherwise provided herein or in any statute, shall be sufficient if given by depositing the same in a United States post office box or receptacle in a sealed, postpaid wrapper, addressed to such Trustee or officer at his or her last address as the same appears on the records of the Trust, and such notice shall be deemed to have been given at the time of such mailing. Additionally, notice may be given by courier service or internet e-mail service with proof of sending and receipt at the last known address of the Trustee as recorded in the records of the Trust.

ARTICLE VII AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

<u>Section 1. Amendments</u>. These Bylaws may be altered or repealed or new Bylaws may be adopted in lieu thereof by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Trustees then in office at any regular or special meeting of the board, if a notice of the proposed alteration, repeal or substitution be contained in the notice of such meeting.

ARTICLE VIII CONTRACT FOR SERVICES

Section 1. Investment/Custodian Services. The Board of Trustee shall have power to appoint such fiscal agents as they deem necessary, to invest and reinvest available funds or gifts, with such requirements of reports from such fiscal agents for services. The Board may authorize any fiscal agents to hold assets in its own name or in the name of its nominee. It may direct that the disbursements be made by the fiscal agents. Further, the Board may authorize the deposit of available funds from time to time in such bank accounts or investments instruments, as it deems prudent.

Section 2. Replacement of Fiduciaries. In accordance with Treasury Regulation Section 1.170A-9(e)(II)(V)(B), the Trust shall have the power to replace any trustee, custodian or agent of the Trust for breach of fiduciary duty under State law and to replace any trustee, custodian or

agent holding or investing funds on behalf of the Trust for failure to produce a reasonable (as determined by the Trust) return of net income over a reasonable (as determined by the Trust) period of time.

Section 3. Investment of Funds. In accordance with Treasure Regulation Section 1.170A(e)(II)(V)(F), the Trust hereby commits itself to obtain information and take other appropriate steps with a view to seeing that each fund that is a component part of the Trust administers such fund in accordance with the terms of its governing instrument and accepted standards of fiduciary conduct to produce a reasonable return of net income or appreciation with due regard to safety of principal in furtherance of the exempt purposes of the Trust.

<u>Section 4. Other Services</u>. The Board of Trustee shall have the right to appoint and engage a CPA to examine or audit the records of the Trust and to pay the expenses of such services; to engage and employ agents or other representatives for any and all proper purposes, including necessary legal counsel.

ARTICLE IX EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS

Section 1. Checks, Drafts, Notes and Orders. All checks, drafts, notes and orders for the payment of money to or by the Trust shall be signed in the name of the Trust by such person or persons, whether or not officers of the Foundation, as shall be empowered to do so by the Board of Directors from time to time.

<u>Section 2. Contracts and Conveyances</u>. Except as otherwise provided by resolution of the Board of Trustees, all formal contract and conveyances of the Trust shall be executed in its name on its behalf by its Chairperson, Vice Chairperson or Treasurer.

ARTICLE X MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 1. Rules of Order. All meetings shall be conducted in accordance with Roberts Rules of Order as amended through 2008. The Chairperson shall act as Parliamentarian unless by a majority vote of the Trustees the Chair is deemed in conflict of interest or out of order. A call by a simple majority of the Trustees for a temporary parliamentarian shall outrank all other motions or votes upon the floor and enjoy a primary position until such time as the temporary parliamentarian rules upon the question at hand. All Trustees shall be bound by the decision of the temporary parliamentarian. Upon a decision rendered the Chairperson shall again preside upon the meeting. Detailed minutes shall be recorded of such extraordinary action.

Section 2. Rules of Operation. The Secretary shall collect and maintain a copy of the Rules of Operation (ROO) which shall be the official standards by which applications for grants, scholarships, and money decisions are made and approved, reimbursement requests are submitted, and general procedures for the daily and routine operations of the Trust are conducted. An updated version shall be provided to all Trustees as frequently as changes occur and shall always be provided as single document encompassing the entire version as so updated.

Versions will be numbered sequentially, and prior versions will be maintained in the files of the Trust. Day to day operating procedures can be brought into the ROO by majority vote of the Trustees at an appropriate meeting and any absent Trustee so notified or unilaterally by the Chairperson. All conditions in the ROO are considered as minimum standard for applications to the Trust and can be deviated from only by exception granted by Executive Committee. All Trustees shall be given notice of such exception no later then the next Board meeting.

Section 3. Dissolution. In the event of dissolution of the Trust, all of the remaining assets and property of the Trust shall, after necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to an organization located in Broward County, Florida, with similar purposes as the Trust and qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and if there is no such organization the assets shall be distributed, in the discretion of the Board of Trustees, to an organization having its principal place of operation in Broward County, Florida, and qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Section IV. Definitions

The term "direct descendent, as used within the by-law, and specifically, Article 1, Section 2, shall mean natural born as well as adopted children as set forth in Florida State Statutes Section 63. 172.
