	a wood stove which gets the smoke out of the houses, conserves wood, and lessens women's wood gathering labor. The local
	people are being assisted in all aspects of stove production. The ICSEE is assisting women start businesses for income to buy
	stoves for their families. Women's teams are being organized and trained to install and maintain stoves.
	Photo voltaic systems for light are being introduced to eliminate kerosene burning as the primary light source in the Maasai homes.
	Ways to help the Maasai spread these benefits to many villages are being developed.
	There are organizations working in Kenya, Uganda, and Rwanda exploring with the ICSEE to see if the stove being produced in
	Tanzania is best suited to help solve health and conservation problems in these countries.
