International Program

The Global Alliance for Incinerator Alternatives uses a movement-building network model that empowers members to build their own capacity, facilitates international solidarity in response to local organizing efforts, and coordinates collective research and campaigns around issues of waste, pollution, climate, and economic justice. In this period, we worked closely with network members and other stakeholders in Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Indonesia, India, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, Nicaraqua, the Philippines, South Africa, Thailand, and Uruquay, in addition to at least a dozen countries in the European Union, and engaged with numerous other countries in all regions of the world. We coordinated various international and regional list-serves reaching a substantial number of our 800+ global member organizations, and helped to link our members to expert resources for public events and environmental impact reviews. We continued to support the development of Zero Waste Europe, a sister network to GAIA that has legal status in the Netherlands, and worked with them to formalize the European Network of Zero Waste Municipalities. GAIA has been supporting an increasing number of members who are leveraging local organizing against pollution into grassroots movements for environmental and economic justice and locally-rooted inclusive zero waste solutions. We organized and supported skillshares and training workshops in several countries (including China, Mexico, India, Spain, France, South Africa, Philippines, and Italy, among other places), and supported the development of new zero waste best practice, as well as the translation into Spanish and Chinese of past publications. We facilitated a number of exchanges among zero waste practitioners and experts, including visits from City of San Francisco officials to

Philippines, and visits by leading European zero waste experts to Latin America. We worked with members on supporting more cities around the world in adopting zero waste goals, including New York City and Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia. We continue to support local and national policy advocacy efforts targeting intergovernmental GAIA continues to collaborate with members on campaigns targeting major banks that provide funding for incineration, including the Green Investment Bank and the Asian Development Bank. GAIA has participated as observers in Green Climate Fund meetings in both Europe and Asia, where we raised the profile of zero waste with our report "A Local Community-based approach to the Green Climate Fund." GAIA played an important role in raising awareness of the health and economic impacts of burning toxic and plastic waste in cement kilns, particularly with regard to the European carbon market and community health impacts in Mexico, El Salvador, and India. Finally, GAIA has raised awareness of the dangers of plastic and other throwaway products for our health and oceans. GAIA members in dozens of countries participated in our International Plastic Bag Free Day, and have supported bans on plastic and Styrofoam products in many countries.

#### U.S. Program

Global Alliance for Incinerator Alternatives provided technical and strategic support, resources, and information to dozens of members and allies in the U.S. as they worked to address pressing waste issues in their communities. We continued to support the Boston Recycling Coalition in research, project development and policy planning to increase the city's recycling rate; worked with partners in Oakland, CA in an effort to increase wages and job quality for recycling workers sorting Oakland's recycling; and supported communities advocating against incinerator proposals in over a dozen U.S. cities. GAIA has increasingly worked to provide

technical support to new cities and communities adopting zero waste goals, and has advocated for city networks to ensure zero waste standards that do not include incineration. We maintained an active members mailing list engaging more than 200 individuals and organizations in the U.S. In addition to supporting grassroots struggle, we have been working on pushing a national conversation and action around waste, justice, and climate. We continued to play a leadership role in the development of the Climate Justice Alliance, and are involving our members in alliances like this one where they can share resources and play a leadership role.
