Program/Discretionary Grants

The Foundation's grant programs will be offered from time to time as directed by the committees charged to operate such programs. For each such program, the respective committee will determine the mission and purpose of the program, set criteria for the awarding of grants, set a schedule for the application for and awarding of grants, ensure the dissemination of the criteria and schedule to likely grantees, review applications, conduct meetings and site visits with prospective grantees as needed, award grants, and evaluate each grant as appropriate.

The Foundation will not make grants to organizations that directly or indirectly promote or engage in violence, terrorism, bigotry or the destruction of any state.

The specific information required to be submitted by grantees will be determined by the committees responsible for each grant program.

Typically, grant proposals will be submitted through a grant application
tailored for such program. No grant application will be reviewed unless
submitted on the appropriate form with all questions answered and the form

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signed	by	an	authorized	representative	of	the	applicant	organization.	

If application information is substantially complete and is submitted by the application deadline, staff members may attempt to obtain any missing information by contacting the applicant. If the applicant is contacted but does not supply the needed information by the date needed, the application will be deemed incomplete and eliminated from consideration by the committee.

Basic information to be submitted in addition to the application or letter of intent should include:

Detailed project budget- including all sources of revenue and the projected use of Community Foundation funds;

Last two (2) years of financial statements, annual reports, audits or tax returns, or statement of financial position. If using a fiscal agent, the organization must submit their financial information as well;

Timeline for accomplishing the goals and objectives outlined in the application;

List of officers, directors and staff for the organization;

discretionary or field of interest funds until option a or b is satisfied
or until the grantee organization has dealt with the misappropriation by
adopting policies, taking disciplinary actions, restructuring the
organization, and/or addressing some key issues. In order for future grant
awards to be considered, Community Foundation staff must be certain that
the grantee organization fully understands the terms and conditions of
foundation grant awards, has acknowledged the misappropriation, and has
taken the appropriate actions to address the issues/situations that allowed
the misappropriation to occur;
3) If the amount of money or the nature of the misappropriation warrants,
the Community Foundation can take legal action to recoup the
misappropriated funds.
Sunset Provisions for Grants & Initiatives Committees
Every five years each committee that is part of the Grants & Initiatives

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evaluation will include reviewing the committee work as it fits into the
Foundation's current strategic plan. The committee will also consider
whether it should continue as is, change or stop. The committee will be
charged with completing this review and presenting their findings to G&I
for approval and ultimately approval by the Board of Governors.

Scholarships

Scholarships are monitored in the following manner. The process of administering Scholarship begins with the initial establishment of the fund. The Community Foundation of Greater Memphis administers a variety of scholarship funds. In many cases these funds have been designed to honor or memorialize citizens from our community. In all cases the funds provide opportunities for students to further their education. A scholarship fund must be endowed with a minimum balance of \$25,000, with three years to reach this minimum.

The donor usually determines the purpose of the scholarship fund when it is created. Once a donor determines who is eligible to apply, they must identify how the scholarship recipients will be chosen from the pool of eligible applicants. Depending on the purpose of the scholarship, certain selection criteria are usually considered in evaluating applicants, such as

- 1. Academic performance and ability to succeed;
- 2. Extra-curricular activities indicate the student's involvement, socialization and

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community	service:

- 3. Letters of reference show how others view student's strengths and weaknesses;
- 4. Volunteer or work experience could illuminate that the student has some experience in his/her chosen career field;
- 5. Clearly stated career and educational goals will show the student's ability to set goals and objectives for his/her future;
- 6. Unusual circumstances identify any family problems, personal or financial, which may warrant further consideration.
- 7. Financial need is demonstrated in the Student Activity Report

 (SAR), which is the information the student receives when they apply

 for financial aid through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid

 (FAFSA).

Reviewing Applicants

Once the criteria have been established, donors must select a review committee. Objectivity is the goal in all cases. Thus individuals from different sectors of the community are utilized to achieve objectivity and provide wider dissemination of information about scholarships. In some cases, committee composition is specified in the agreement establishing the scholarship fund. Representatives from specific organizations might be named. Donors or family members may serve as advisors to the scholarship fund, but non-family members must make up the majority of the committee. While committees can function well without members representing the field of education, it is encouraged to include one member (or non-voting advisor) who has experience with issues related to college admissions or financial aid.
