In FY 2015, the Hospital subsidized health care services to the community in the amount of \$4,232,324. This included support for primary care services, community wellness programs and grants, mental health services, EMS training, community health advocacy and the medication bridge program. With a focus on wellness, primary care is of the utmost importance to our patients and their families. The Organization has locations for primary care in New London and Newport NH to expand access to the communities we serve. The Organization has developed wellness programs to offer education and provide assistance to our community members in making and sustaining healthier lifestyle choices. Costs incurred for subsidizing primary care and implementing wellness initiatives in our community amounted to over \$4.2 million dollars for fiscal year 2015. The cost of prescription drugs is often beyond the means of many of the residents in our community. On the basis of historical experience, a portion of the Association's uninsured patients will be unable to or unwilling to pay for the services rendered. Thus, the Association records a significant provision for bad debts related to uninsured patients in the period services are provided. The Hospital used the cost-to-charge ratio for reporting bad debt expense at cost. The estimate of bad debt attributable to charity was based upon historical experience.
