FROM THE PUBLICITY REQUIREMENT AS A SCHOOL THAT CUSTOMARILY DRAWS ITS STUDENTS FROM
LOCAL COMMUNITIES AND FOLLOWS A RACIALLY NONDISCRIMINATORY POLICY AS TO STUDENTS.
