THE PARTNERSHIP IS DESIGNED TO FOSTER THE DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND HIGH QUALITY PROGRAMS/SERVICES, PROVIDE BETTER ACCESS TO MEMBERS AND CLIENTS, SHARE EXPENSES, AND USE PHILANTHROPIC AND VOLUNTEER RESOURCES MOST EFFECTIVELY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE COMMUNITY.

AS A FUNDER OF EACH OF THE ORGANIZATIONS, THE NORTH PENN COMMUNITY HEALTH FOUNDATION SAW THE OPPORTUNITY FOR COLLABORATION AND BROUGHT THE LEADERS OF THE FOUR AGENCIES TOGETHER TO DISCUSS A COORDINATED APPROACH. AFTER A SERIES OF FACILITATED BOARD CHAIR AND CEO LEADERSHIP MEETINGS, THE FOUR AGENCIES PLEDGED TO WORK TOGETHER AND NEGOTIATED A SET OF LEGAL AGREEMENTS TO HELP GUIDE THEIR INVESTMENT IN THIS INNOVATIVE APPROACH TO COMMUNITY SERVICE.

THE FOUNDATION PROVIDES SUPPORT FOR THE COORDINATION OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF A FUNDRAISING PLAN AND THE SUPPORT OF THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN, PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT COSTS AND OTHER CONSULTANTS NECESSARY TO COORDINATE THE PROJECT.

IN JULY 2013 THE PROJECT, NOW KNOWN AS NORTH PENN COMMONS, WAS AWARDED \$11.6 MILLION IN LOW-INCOME HOUSING TAX CREDITS OVER A TEN YEAR PERIOD. NORTH PENN COMMONS WILL BE HOME TO 60 AFFORDABLE INDEPENDENT LIVING UNITS FOR SENIORS, A LARGER UPGRADED SOUP KITCHEN, CHOICE FOOD PANTRY AND NORTH PENN COMMONS PUBLIC CAFE, PROGRAMS TO HELP OLDER ADULTS LIVE INDEPENDENTLY AND REMAIN ACTIVE AND AN UPGRADED AND EXPANDED ZERO-ENTRY FAMILY POOL, SIX LANE MULTI-PURPOSE POOL ALL CONNECTED BY AN ALL ACCESS LOBBY WHICH WILL SERVE AS THE HUB OF ACTIVITY FOR ALL RESIDENTS. MEMBERS, CLIENTS AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS. THE CENTER IS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION WITH AN ANTICIPATED OPENING DATE IN THE FALL OF 2016.
