IMPROVE THE LINKS BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY AND ITS ALUMNI. THESE LINKS HAVE ASSISTED THE UNIVERSITY IN ITS EFFORTS TO INCREASE THE OUALITY OF INSTRUCTION, EXPAND THE FIELDS OF STUDY AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS AND ENHANCE THE CAREER OPPORTUNITIES OF ITS GRADUATES. THE UNIVERSITY CONSIDERS THE SUPPORT OF THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION VITAL TO ITS ON-GOING SUCCESS AS AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING.
