Each position within the scope of the project was assigned to a career track, job family and sub-family based upon the job documentation on file for the position. Positions were market-priced based upon the assignment of their sub-family and job level. Pay grades were assigned based upon a market analysis conducted by a consultant. The University now has one pay structure for all non-bargaining classified and administrative jobs. The OHIO Board of Trustees approved the pay structure at their October 17, 2014, meeting and the pay structure went into effect with the start of the first pay period in November 2014
