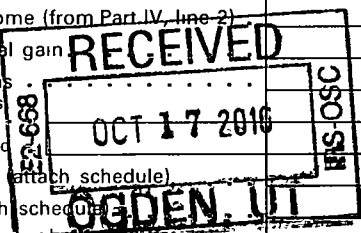

The adjusted qualifying distributions and Net Value of non-charitable-use assets have been split proratably between the two existing funds, Evenor Fund and SuPau Fund. This completes the appropriate reporting requirements for attribute splitting for a substantial contraction.

The Armington, Evenor fund still has some assets that will be distributed in kind for tax year 2015 and file a final return for 06/30/2016.

The excess distribution carry over figures have been adjusted by the percentages we are carrying over to the Evenor Fund and Supau Trust. These two receiving foundations will then adjust their own Part VII to include these excess distributions going forward.
