In comparing HUD guidelines to the Federal Poverty Guidelines ("FPG"), we find that on average HUD guidelines compute to approximately 200% to 250% (and sometimes 300%) of FPG. Alegent Health-Mercy Hospital bases its financial assistance eligibility on HUD's 130% of Very Low Income Guidelines based on geography, and affords the uninsured and underinsured the ability to obtain financial assistance write-offs, based on a sliding scale, ranging from 25%-100% of charges. However, in determining whether to extend discounted or free care to a patient, the patient's assets may also be taken into consideration. Such a patient may be extended discounted or free care based upon the facts and circumstances.
