 TO BY THE PRESIDENT AND CEO AND BOARD CHAIR, WITH SIGNIFICANT INPUT FROM THE

 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. COMPENSATION DECISIONS ARE DOCUMENTED

 IN THE ORGANIZATIONS' BOOKS AND RECORDS.
