Skills, experience and performance history of individual executives,. Critical business or strategic issues that the organization may face, and. Market position for total compensation. The adequacy, competitiveness, and cost of the VCH total executive compensation program are reviewed on an ongoing basis and changes are made as the Committee determines appropriate. The executive compensation program will be maintained such that it will fall within the safe harbor guidelines established by the intermediate sanctions regulations. The Committee also employs the services of an independent
