Every year, the package is reviewed to determine if an increase is to be given to the CEO as well as to evaluate the CEO's performance for the past year to decide if he has earned any or all of his incentive pay. Compensation for all other employees including the Chief Financial Officer, Chief Marketing Officer and other key employees is determined by a salary survey that is conducted by an independent contractor every THREE years and is updated by the independent contractor annually for Florida industry average increases within each position's salary range.
