Such statements are reviewed by the Executive Director and Chief Financial Officer and further reviewed by the President, Executive Committee and the Trusteeship Committee as necessary. Part VI - Section B, Line 15 - The Executive Director is evaluated by the University President and the Executive Committee using an assessment tool. The Executive Director is also interviewed and evaluated by Executive Committee members who review comparable University administrators' salaries and available industry ranges to determine a recommended salary. The Executive Director and the Finance Chair review the CFO's salary and compare it to the salaries of similar University positions and available industry ranges. All salary recommendations are incorporated into annual budgets which are reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors.
