The School acts as custodian for cash held for student groups, which is restricted for the specific use of graduation classes and other student groups.

Part V, Line 4 - Intended Uses for Endowment Funds

On February 7, 2015, the School organized the Trust and during the year ended June 30, 2015 the Board of Directors approved the creation of a Trust to be used for student scholarships, capital funding and other funds.

On June 23, 2015 the Board of Directors approved the transfer of the school cash held for scholarship fund net assets to the Trust and on such date the net assets were transferred to the Trust.

The Deed of Trust appointed as Trustee a Governing Board to be comprised by

the President of the School's Board of DIrectors ("the Board"), the Board
Treasurer and a Governance Officer of the Board.

The Trust may invest in any property or instrument considered appropriate by the Trustee. The Trustee has established that the net income after the payment of trust expenses derived from the Trust corpus may be distributed to the Grantor (the School) to be used for the purposes approved by the Board of Directors of the School. The net income refer to all income and benefits that are received by the Trust, excluding the net gain realized by the sale of assets and proceeds of any life insurance policy in which the Trust is the beneficiary. These shall be consider corpus of the Trust.

The Trust will have a perpetual existence, or at least to exist during the existence of the School, or as otherwise provided upon applicable law.

#### Part X - FIN 48 Footnote

The Baldwin School of Puerto Rico, Inc. is eligible for exemption from Puerto Rico income taxes under section 1101(4) of the Puerto Rico Internal Revenue Code of 1994, as amended. In addition, it has been classified as a not-for-profit entity under section 501(a) of the US Internal Revenue Code and exempt from US income taxes. Accordingly, no provision or liability for Puerto Rico or federal income taxes has been recorded.

The School follows accounting standards relating to accounting for uncertainty in income taxes. As a result of this guidance, management assessed whether there were any uncertain tax positions which may give rise to income tax liabilities and determined that there were no such matters

requiring recognition in the accompanying financial statements. The School filed income tax returns only in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, With few exceptions the School is no longer subject to income tax examinations by tax authorities for years before 2010.
