Senior Services includes the Meals on Wheels program and the AniMeals on Wheels program. Meals on Wheels delivers hot,
nutritious weekday meals to homebound senior citizens, as well as breakfast and weekend meals to the most frail and isolated
seniors. IMGH delivered 1.5 million meals, with an average of 4,000 seniors served each weekday in this fiscal period. 920 seniors
received additional breakfast and weekend meals to supplement their daily lunch delivery. 700 seniors were assisted by IMGH social
services staff, who provided case management and referrals to partner agencies for additional services. IMGH's special Thanksgiving
meal, which was delivered almost exclusively by volunteers, brightened the holiday of almost 2,000 seniors. IMGH also delivered over
15,000 donated items to seniors, including fans, household items, blankets and holiday gifts. The AniMeals on Wheels program
delivers pet food to seniors with pets, so they will not have to share their limited food resources with their animal companions. Over
550 seniors and 1,100 pets participate in this program, with almost 74,000 pounds of donated pet food delivered by volunteers during
this fiscal period.
The Meals on Wheels program received \$19,000 worth of donated facility space during this fiscal period.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 5,252,119 including grants of \$ 3,568,086) (Revenue \$ 0)
The Refugee Services program assists in the resettlement of refugees fleeing their homeland in fear of political, social or religious
persecution. Services provided include food, housing, transportation and medical assistance, donated furniture, home furnishings
and clothing, cultural orientation and employment assistance, translation and educational assistance, and other services designed
to help refugees become self-sufficient within six months of arrival in Houston. In this fiscal period, IMGH resettled over 760
refugees from 12 countries, 94% of whom were self-sufficient within six months. IMGH also assisted another 632 clients with
case management and other supplemental services, for a total of almost 1,400 individuals served.
The Refugee Services program received \$84,000 worth of donated refugee housing and \$225,000 worth of donated legal services
in this fiscal period.

The Interfaith Relations program fosters understanding, respect and engagement among people of all faiths through educational
opportunities and community service. Adult programming includes Dinner Dialogues, the World Religions Lecture Series, and a Faith
Leaders Lunch, with over 700 people participating in this fiscal period. IMGH's youth programming focused on the ILEAD Interfaith
Youth Leadership program, which grew from 14 to 25 enrolled students in this fiscal period. The Interfaith Relations program also
hosted or facilitated over 50 community events, including faith tours, speaker panels and individual presentations.
The Disaster Preparedness and Response program works with nonprofits, religious institutions and government agencies year-round
to prepare for disasters. More than 180 individuals from the Houston Interfaith Disaster Response Alliance (HIDRA) came together
to learn about preparing for serious incidents, including hurricanes and human-caused emergencies, and to respond to humanitarian
need across the Greater Houston region.

Part III, Line 4d/Explanation of IM Support - IM Support was organized in August 2013 as a Texas nonprofit corporation to secure New Market Tax Credits financing for the construction of the W T and Louise J Moran Building and the renovations of the Albert and Ethel Herzstein Building, and to hold ownership of these properties for use by Interfaith Ministries for Greater Houston. Line 4d represents assets donated to IM Support from Interfaith Ministries.

Volunteer Services - Interfaith Ministries received volunteer support from almost 6,300 volunteers in this fiscal period. These volunteers donated over 63,000 hours of their time in support of IM's program service areas. Volunteer opportunities include senior meal packaging and delivery, pet meal packaging and delivery, English language instruction and cultural orientation for refugees, interfaith event hosting, and senior disaster assistance.

Capital Campaign - Interfaith Ministries is in its fourth year of a multi-year capital campaign called Many Faiths Building Together. This campaign has enabled the organization to purchase a new headquarters building with space for a community conference center, as well as adjacent vacant land upon which a new Meals on Wheels distribution center was built. As part of the campaign, IM has received \$8,000 in donated architectural and design services and \$5,000 in donated fundraising services in this fiscal period.
