the CJC Program is to reduce trauma to victims of child abuse, particularly sexual and physical abuse, by coordinating and facilitating the
criminal justice system and child protective system response to these victims through a multidisciplinary team intervention in a safe, non-
threatening child-friendly facility known as the Children's Justice Center. This home-like facility and a much needed major addition to this
facility are held in trust for the community by the Friends of Utah County Children's Justice Center non-profit charitable organization.
Additionally, we provide funding to the CJC Program, which functions under Utah County government, as needed, as well as funding for child
abuse victim treatment for abused children and their impacted families to promote healing and restoration to productive lives. Support can
include training for MDT professionals and medical services. We also provide public awareness and education regarding child abuse issues
in our community to involve the community in being part of the solution to these issues, as part of our charitable purpose. We continue to
support the healing programs of the Utah County Children's Justice Center, as well as providing funding to periodically refurbish, maintain,
and refurnish the CJC facility, including replacing and upgrading essential equipment, as needed, as part of our charitable purpose. We also
continue to receive significant non-cash contributions that provide much needed clothing, toys, books, etc. for child clients and families who
are very needy during this time of crisis in their lives. We strive to promote hope and healing their young lives.
