	The University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) and the UNLV Foundation had a successful fundraising year in fiscal year (FY) 2015. During the year, individuals, corporations, and foundations contributed \$26,755,447 to UNLV and the UNLV Foundation in gifts, private grants, gifts-in-kind and gifts-of-service. This number does not include \$17,776,063 from payments received on pledges from previous years. In addition, UNLV also received \$48,130,224 in new gift and estate commitments not counted in the number above. The combined total of new gifts plus new gift commitments in FY 2015 is \$74,885,671. This was the largest fundraising year at UNLV since the conclusion of the Invent the Future campaign in 2009. In all, 10,405 alumni, friends, foundations and corporations gave 20,745 gifts to UNLV during the fiscal year - resulting in 3.5% and 7% growth respectively over FY 2014. Gift Highlights - In March, the university announced a \$20 million commitment from the Rogers Foundation to support the Black Mountain Institute. - The Engelstad Family Foundation leadership gift of \$10 million was given to add 100 full four-year scholarships to students in the Medical School. Several others also supported the Medical School to add another \$3.5 million for a total of 135 full four-year scholarships. - The estate of Kitty Rodman contributed \$12.5 million to support scholarships and graduate fellowships in the College of Education. - The Thomas and Mack families committed \$3.25 million to support Thomas & Mack Center improvements and \$750,000 to support the Boyd School of Law. - A \$3 million gift was given by the Cox family to create the Fred and Harriet Cox Endowed Senior Design Fund to support the College of Engineering Senior Design Competition. - The Foundation received gift commitments by Diana Bennett of \$1 million each for Black Mountain Institute and Honors College Scholarships. - With over 800 guests at the Foundation annual dinner, we celebrated Switch and its CEO, UNLV Foundation Trustee, Rob Roy, for reaching \$1 million cumulative support to UNLV. Keynote speaker Anderson Cooper also announced he would be making a gift of his honorarium.

In order to fulfill this responsibility, OSP establishes separate and unique accounts for each project in our financial system with a corresponding budget. Maintaining separate accounts allows us to segregate grant and contract funds so we can track costs for each award separately, assure all costs are allowable for each award, and that all expenses fall within the approved budget parameters. This practice ensures internal control over both the source and application of funds and is in line with federal requirements found in 2 CFR Chapter I, and Chapter II, Part 200 Uniform Administrative Requirements, state regulations, and university policy. UNLV is also audited annually to confirm that we continue to maintain adequate financial controls and surveillance procedures to assure ongoing compliance. A few of the tasks UNLV performs to assure financial compliance include: 1. Regularly monitoring award expenditures to make sure costs are appropriately processed and classified within the approved object/sub-object categories. 2. Maintaining an encumbrance system of expected future expenditures through the MUNIS Purchasing System. 3. Reconciling awards monthly, and processing any necessary corrections. 4. Provide assistance to departmental administrators, principle investigators, and other campus staff for their sponsored programs and related financial transactions. 5. Provide oversight and corrective action on sponsored award financial issues. 6. Submit regular invoices and financial reports to sponsor. 7. Review all costs that post to a sponsored project within the final 90 days of the award to determine if, and how, costs benefited an award. 8. Conduct a final review when the award is ending to determine if all costs were incurred while the award was active and all costs were allowable.
