Grantmaking Policy

John M. Ross Foundation regularly accepts unsolicited grant requests from qualified tax-exempt 501 (c)(3) charitable organizations on the Big Island of Hawaii that have programs or projects focusing on teens from 11-18 years of age.

PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO PROGRAMS/PROJECTS THAT SUPPORT TEENS WHO HAVE HIGHER NEEDS AND LIMITED ACCESS. The following are examples of what Ross Foundation considers to be "higher needs and limited access": financial need, little or no family support, limited access to transportation, resources, and/or activities.

The Governing Board wishes to continue its support of teen programs. Organizations from various sectors on the Big Island are invited to submit a grant request to John M. Ross Foundation for *possible* funding consideration ranging from \$1,000 - \$5,000. The funds cannot be used toward large capital projects.

DEADLINE: Applications must be postmarked by February 1.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES - A thru D

Submit Four (4) completed sets of the proposal containing:

- (A) Funding Request cover sheet – To be placed on top of each set (see page 4).
- (B) Proposal Narrative – Provide who, what, when, where, why, and how in three pages or less.

Narrative Format Information:

Pages: Maximum 3 pages
Margins: 1-inch margins on each side
Font: 12 point font
Spacing: Double space in between paragraphs
Paragraph Height: Maximum of 1 ½ inches
Bullet points: Acceptable

Narrative Headings: Use these 7 (seven) headings in the order listed:

- 1) **Organization:** Briefly describe your organization's mission and programs. (maximum of 3 sentences)
- 2) **Population to be Served:** Provide an estimated UNDUPLICATED number and age range of the eligible individuals you propose to serve.
 - o If the projections are an increase over the current volume, provide information on current volume (percentages can only be used if accompanied with figures, i.e. 20% over 500).
- 3) **Program/Project:** Describe using specific information in layman terms.
 - o (Acronyms must be explained in the narrative and budgets.)
- 4) **Goals & Objectives:** **Separately** list each goal with corresponding objective, and specifically describe how the goal will be accomplished through the objective.
- 5) **Outreach:** For new, expansion, or existing program/project:
 - o Describe how your organization will market the program/project to the community you propose to serve.
 - o Provide an estimated UNDUPLICATED number of group/individuals who will be new participants
 - o Provide UNDUPLICATED numbers for existing participants/groups/individuals.
- 6) **Evaluation:** Provide information on how and/or what the following measures are that will be used to evaluate the program/project (**note:** pre/post-tests are not acceptable):
 - o Process Measures – extent to how the program/project will be implemented
 - o Outcome Measures – effectiveness in meeting goals and objectives
- 7) **Cost:** Total cost of the program/project, amount requested, and plans for future support.

(C) These 7 items must be attached to each of the 4 (four) sets of the proposal narrative

- Staff: Describe the qualifications of the staff or volunteers who will oversee and coordinate the program/project
- Board of Directors - List of Board members with their professional or business affiliation.
 - Percent who actively participate in activities and attend meetings
- Endorsement Letters - Two letters endorsing the activity

(The following items must have a Start & End date that includes: month, day and year)

- Project/Program Budget
 - List all revenue (funding sources) and expenses for the project or program.
 - Requests for small capital and/or to purchase equipment require additional information to validate the expenses in the project budget (i.e. estimates from vendors).
- Organization's Operating Budget – Current Fiscal Year
 - If funding is for support during the following fiscal year, also provide a DRAFT of Operating Budget for such year.
- Income Statement - Recently Completed Fiscal Year
- Current Balance Sheet - (not older than three months)

(D) IRS, Charters, By-Laws, Articles of Incorporation

Provide One copy only:

- Internal Revenue Service letter advising that the organization is tax-exempt under Section 501(c) (3) of the Code, and its status under 509(a).
