The Foundation's Board of Directors serves as an Advisory Committee to advise the Sponsoring Organization of its wishes concerning distributions from the donor advised fund, but understands that the Sponsoring Organization will evaluate whether the advice is consistent with the specific needs of the proposed recipient and deserving of the support according to the criteria of the Sponsoring Organization All funds held in the donor advised fund are normally distributed to selected grantees within six months of the Foundation's distribution to the donor advised fund

The loan agreement additionally indicates that any portion of the funds not used for the intended purposes is required to be repaid 3. Periodic reporting. The Foundation receives regular repayments of the loan from the missionaries and the balance on the loan is current. The Foundation will also receive periodic updates fr
