Dedicated to the belief that in the profession of medicine we will improve care for all by recognizing high educational achievement; honoring gifted teaching; encouraging the development of leaders in academia and the community; supporting the ideals of humanism; and promoting service to others.

Visiting Professorships - Any medical school with an active AOA chapter may host one visiting professorship during each academic year, funded by the national office. The visiting professor shall contribute one full day or more of teaching and interacting with students, residents, and faculty. The event shall be titled the AOA Visiting Professorship and this title shall be included on posters, announcements, and press releases. The AOA Chapter must submit a one-page summary of the visit and activities to the national office within 30 days of the visit for auditing purposes. Required activities include clinical rounds, research discussions, teaching conferences, seminars, of which one or more sessions must be on leadership and/or medical professionalism. Additional recommended activities may include departmental Grand Rounds, a presentation or major address to the medical school community and/or attend and present at the annual Chapter AOA nomination banquet. Expenses and honorarium for 67 visiting professors were paid in 2014. (\$169,185 expenses incl. \$90,000 in grants)

Insignia and Certification of Members - Membership is verified before an order for a key and/or certificate can be placed. The AOA key is a symbol of membership in the society. Keys are engraved with member's initials, chapter Greek letter and state, and year of election. An active member may order as many certificates as needed.

Members and family can also purchase ties and scarves. (\$148,215)

Professionalism in Medicine - Recognizes and honors outstanding faculty and programs with the best practices in medical professionalism education. Up to three one-time awards can be given annually based on a national competition. The award is for ongoing programs in medical schools and/or affiliated institutions that represent best practices in the teaching and learning of medical professionalism - effectiveness, sustainability, and exportability to other medical institutions. Faculty and programs at medical schools that have an active chapter of Alpha Omega Alpha are eligible. Institutions affiliated with medical schools with an active AOA chapter are also eligible. Medical schools whose nominee has won the Professionalism Award are not eligible to submit another nominee for three subsequent years. One award was given in 2014.

(\$112,367 in expenses incl. \$10,000 grants)

Medical Student Service Leadership Project - Service learning provides an excellent opportunity for students to develop as servant leaders. Only one team from each school with an AOA chapter or association may be nominated. Teams with AOA members serving as team leaders are given priority, as are proposals with matching institutional or dean's funds. Only one proposal may be submitted for each institution for each three years of funding. Applications must be for new projects with the potential to generate future support from the medical school or other sources, not supplemental funding for existing programs. A new component of an existing program may be eligible. Teams must hold regular team meetings with the mentor related to leadership, service, and reflection; participate in a continuous, defined and structured school or institutional leadership development program for students related to health care, medicine, or medical education; conduct a service learning project for an underserved population, e.g., the indigent, immigrants,

homeless, etc., or a service project related to professionalism in the school, hospital, or clinics; submit an annual progress report for each year and a final report to the AOA national office upon completion of the third year, with funding for the second and third years being contingent on acceptance of the report for the previous year's work. Five awards were given in 2014. (\$94,035 in expenses, incl. \$63,000 grants)

Chapter Development - In 2014, AOA had 124 active medical school Chapters. Two new Chapters were established by the AOA Board of Directors in 2014 - Commonwealth Medical College in Pennsylvania, and Virginia Tech Carillon School of Medicine. (\$89,657 in expenses)

Distinguished Teacher Awards - presented annually at the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) awards dinner to two basic science faculty and two by the President of Alpha Omega Alpha, the award recognizes outstanding contributions to the education of medical students by four faculty - two basic sciences and two clinical - at LCME-approved schools of medicine.Nominees are vetted by a review committee jointly appointed by AOA and the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) and composed of past award winners. Each school may submit one application every fourth year. (\$82,521 in expenses, incl. \$53,000 in grants)

Essay & Poetry Awards - To encourage medical students to write creative narratives, scholarly essays or poetry relevant to medicine. Authors must be enrolled at medical schools with active ?O? chapters or associations, but need not be members of ?O?.

Only one entry may be submitted per student.

Essays must be written while the student is in medical school, must be the work of a single author, and must represent original work. The work may be on any nontechnical subject related to medicine, and must not have been offered to or published by any other journal or entered in any other contest, and must uphold a high standard of professionalism, compassion and humanism in medicine. A committee of the Editorial Board of The Pharos reviews the essays and poems and selects the winners. Judging is based on originality, scholarship, style and composition, and relevance. Four student essay awards, and five poetry awards were given in 2014. (\$21,227 in expenses, incl \$4,900 grants)

Post Graduate Award - Provides support to allow residents or fellows to pursue a research project or a scholarly project fulfilling the requirements for scholarly activity by the ACGME in the spirit of the AOA mission statement. Priority for scholarly projects is given to those in the areas of leadership, professionalism, and teaching. Ten awards were given in 2014. Schools, departments, and/or programs are encouraged to provide additional or matching funds. Medical residents and fellows from programs at institutions with an active AOA chapter or association are eligible. Only one application will be accepted from each chapter, and applicants need not be AOA members. Ten awards were given in 2014. (\$20,714 expenses, incl \$4,000 in grants)

Volunteer Clinical Faculty Award - To recognize a community physician who contributes with distinction to the education and training of clinical students.

The national office of AOA has provided a permanent plaque for the Dean's office and sends a plate with the name of each awardee to be added to it. Recipients of the

award are eligible to receive it only once. Nominees need not be members of AOA, nor does the award confer AOA membership. Nominations for the Volunteer Clinical Faculty Award may be made by all clinical students, with the recipient chosen by student members of the AOA chapter. Forty-two awards were given in 2014. (Expenses \$4.039)

Administrative Recognition Award - To recognize the invaluable work performed by chapter administrative personnel to keep the chapter running smoothly. These individuals are typically responsible for keeping membership and financial records, making arrangements for visiting professorships, and making plans for the annual banquet. Administrators who have provided administrative support for a chapter for at least three or more consecutive years are eligible. After three subsequent years of continued service, a recipient becomes eligible to receive this award again. Eight awards were given in 2014. (Expenses \$3,525 incl. \$1,250 awards)
