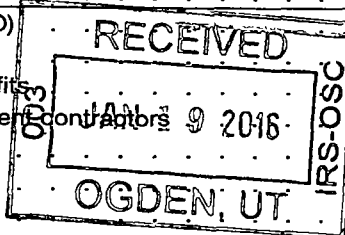

2. Nominations for Kora Coordinator and/or Associate Kora Coordinator may not be made from the floor unless the candidate's qualifications have been reviewed and certified by the National Executive Board.

PART V, LIN 34, CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGES - CONTINUED

Article XIII, Section 6 - National Finance

"There shall be four permanent National funds plus a General Fund. The National funds are as follows:" -- this language is deleted

Paragraphs A thru D are changed to B thru E. A new paragraph A is added as follows.

A. The General Operational Fund is used to carry out the ongoing operations and administration of the National Kappa Phi Club.

A new paragraph 6 is added under E as follows:

6. The Century Fund provides an endowment to support the General Fund in order to sustain the administrative work of the Club.

a. This endowment was established by funds contributed in celebration of the first 100 year anniversary and in honor of Jean Chirpas upon her retirement as National Sponsor. Additions may be made in the form of gifts, memorials and donations

b. The original contribution of \$11,500 shall remain permanently endowed. Onehalf of all additional contributions will be added to the endowment. The other half of new contributions and all interest earned may be used to support the ongoing administrative work of the national organization.

c. The National Executive Board shall approve all expenditures from this fund.

Article XV, Section 8 Vacancies - Paragraph B is amended to read as follows

B. In the event of a vacancy in the office of Kora Coordinator, the Associate Kora Coordinator will immediately assume the Kora Coordinator duties. If no Associate Kora Coordinator is serving at the time, nominations for an interim Kora Coordinator shall be secured and submitted to the National Executive Board for evaluation and recommendations. Following the recommendations of the National Executive Board, the Kora Board will vote, on behalf of the Kora, for the interim Kora Coordinator. At the next Kora Conference a new Kora Coordinator will be elected by the Kora delegation.

Article XVII, Section 2 - Alumnae Membership - paragraph A is amended to read as follows:

A. Any initiated member who has received or is eligible for the Degree of the Rose, or who was initiated as a Sponsor or Honorary Member, is eligible for alumna membership.
