Explanation: While the Foundation does not qualify as publicly supported under the mechanical 33 1/3 percent-of-support test set forth in the IRS Regulations, the Foundation should be considered a publicly supported charity under the facts and circumstances as set forth in the IRS Regulations.

Under the facts and circumstances test, an organization will be treated as publicly supported if it establishes, under all the facts and circumstances, that (i) it normally receives a substantial part of its support from government units or from direct or indirect contributions from the general public, and (ii) it is of the nature of a "publicly supported organization, taking into account the factors described in the Regulations. As described below, the Foundation submits that it satisfies the facts and circumstances test for recognition as a publicly supported organization.

- (1) The Foundation has ongoing and continuous programs to solicit support from the general public and from its constituents, which consist of Pharmacists operating in Georgia. These programs include a direct mail fundraising campaign, solicitation on its website and in The Georgia Pharmacy Journal, a professional journal for Georgia Pharmacists. The scope of the Foundation's solicitation program is reasonable in light of its focus on the pharmacy community in Georgia.
- The IRS Regulations provide that the fact that an organization meets the requirement through support from governmental units or directly or indirectly from a representative number of persons, rather than receiving almost all of its support from the members of a single family, will be taken into consideration in determining whether an organization is

"publicly supported." In determining what is a "representative number of 432028 09-17-14 Schedule A (Form 990 or 990-EZ) 2014 persons," consideration will be given to the type of organization involved, the length of time it has been in existence, and whether it limits its activities to a particular community or region or to a special field which can be expected to appeal to a limited number of persons. The Foundation's support is derived from a variety of sources, including investment income, rental income, program service fees and contributed income. No single individual or family provides a significant amount of the Foundation's support.

(3) The IRS Regulations provide that the fact that an organization has a governing body which represents the broad interests of the public, other than the personal or private interests of a limited number of donors (or persons standing in a relationship to such donors, will be taken into account in determining whether an organization is "publicly supported." The Foundation's Board of Directors is separate and diverse and has no Directors with a family relationship or a business relationship with any other Officers, Directors or Key Employees. All members of the Board have expertise in the field of Pharmacy and most are either practicing or retired Pharmacists. Because the Foundation's charitable
