Part III Line 28 The events were held at various locations between Portland and the Willamette Valley region of Western Oregon and topics included a discussion on the effects of community-based policy efforts in farm to school and "Sake - What is it anyway?". The December meeting also functioned as a fundraiser for the Oegon Food Bank. Attendance for these evens ranged from 35 to 52 with an average attendance of 38.

The largest annual event the organization hosts is their Suppliers Night, called FIX*, or Food Ingredient eXpo*. FIX* brings local and national suppliers of food ingredients, services and equipment together with local food industry technical personnel, especially those with research and development and quality assurance responsibilities. The goal is to improve the competitiveness of the local food industry. Approximately 150 vendors set up booths at the event, which is free to the general public.

OSIFT awarded 6 scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 during the fiscal year to students in the Food Science and Technology Department at Oregon State University. In addition, 3 travel grants were awarded to students to travel to the national Institute of Food Technologies Expo.
